James D. Tindall moved to recommend for perfection Ordinance #4029, appropriating \$23,000.00 from the fund balance of the 2008 Anti-Drug Sales Tax Fund to restore the 2006 funding level to Guadalupe Center, and authorizing an amendment to the current contract with Guadalupe Center, at a cost to the County not to exceed \$23,000.00. Seconded by Scott Burnett.

Henry C. Rizzo moved to hold Ordinance #4034, transferring \$156,929.00 within and appropriating \$375,877.00 from the fund balance of the 2008 Anti-Drug Sales Tax Fund, in acceptance of the Drug Abatement Response Team (DART) grant for the Prosecuting Attorney's Office awarded by the Missouri Department of Public Safety, and authorizing the County Executive to execute a Memorandum of Understanding with the City of Kansas City, MO, and the Kansas City Board of Police Commissioners relating to the DART program, at a cost to the County not to exceed \$91,000.00. Seconded by James D. Tindall.

Rizzo moved to hold Resolution #16708, authorizing the County Executive to execute a Cooperative Agreement with the Kansas City, MO, Neighborhood and Community Services Department for its Neighborhood Improvement Plan Initiative, at a cost to the County not to exceed \$75,000.00. Seconded by James D. Tindall.

Henry C. Rizzo moved to recommend do pass Resolution #16709, transferring \$131,240.00 within the 2008 Anti-Drug Sales Tax Fund to fund professional service contracts recommended by the Executive Transition Team, and awarding a five (5) month contract for the creation of a prevention program team to assess future funding for drug prevention agencies and a four (4) month contract for the redesign of Drug Prevention Agency reporting and internal monitoring, both for use by the Jackson County COMBAT Commission, as sole source purchases, to Resource Development Institute (RDI) of Kansas City, MO, at a total cost to the County not to exceed \$50,000.00. Seconded by James D. Tindall.
