REQUEST SUMMARY	Ordinance requested appropriating \$250,000 from the unappropriated surplus of the 2010 Grant Fund in acceptance of a grant from the Federal Highway Administration under the American Recovery and Reinvestment Act (ARRA). Ordinance 4115 was approved on July 6, 2009 authorizing execution of the Cooperative Agreement.			
	The Department of Public Works solicited bids for this project for 3 weeks. Sealed proposals were opened on January 28, 2010 at the offices of Public Works. Seventeen (17) firms submitted bids. A recapitulation of all bids is included as an attachment to this RLA.			

	It is recommended that the project be awarded to Precision Construction & Contracting, LLC, being the lowe and best bidder, in the amount of \$444,607.05, subject to approval by MoDOT. ORDINANCE #4115, July 6, 2009

INTRODUCED BY Fred Arbanas, County Legislator

WHEREAS, the Longview Lake Trail is in need of reconstruction; and,

WHEREAS, a grant opportunity was offered through the Mid America Regional Counsel (MARC) under the American Recovery and Reinvestment Act; and,

WHEREAS, the County has applied for funds for the reconstruction of the Longview Lake Trail, and the application was approved in the amount of \$250,000.00 for the rehabilitation; and,

WHEREAS, the attached Intergovernmental Cooperative Agreement is necessary for the County to accept these funds; and,

WHEREAS, the Missouri Department of Transportation specifically requested the adoption of an ordinance authorizing the supplemental agreement pursuant to the federal reimbursement requirements; and,

WHEREAS, this Agreement is recommended by the Public Works Department; and,

WHEREAS, this Agreement is in the best interest of the health, welfare, and safety of the citizens of the County; now therefore,

BE IT ORDAINED by the County Legislature of Jackson County, Missouri, that the County Executive be and hereby is authorized to execute the attached Intergovernmental Cooperative Agreement with the Missouri Department of Transportation to receive grant monies for use on the Longview Lake Trail Replacement.

Effective Date: This ordinance shall be effective immediately upon its signature by the County Executive.
