Project/Title:

Transferring \$3,200,000 in Jackson County American Rescue Plan -Public Health Funds in the ARPA Fund (No. 050) for the purpose of funding the continuing COVID-19 response; updating the County's Health Improvement Plan; and other community health initiatives for the Jackson County Health Department for fiscal year 2022.

Request Summary

This resolution requests the transfer of \$3,200,000 in appropriated ARPA-Public Health Funds to the Jackson County Health Department to continue the public health response to COVID-19. This funding will support staffing, testing and vaccination supplies, and equipment replacement costs. In additon, the Jackson County Health Department will begin to update its Community Health Improvement Plan to address the long-term impacts of COVID-19 and to continue its accreditation efforts which were halted because of the pandemic.
