Dennis Waits, County Legislator, recognized the students, adult sponsors and the Chairperson of the Independence/Japanese Sister City Program. 5 COMMUNICATIONS AND REPORTS OF THE COUNTY EXECUTIVE

Troy Thomas, Manager of Finance, announced that there was a water main break at 25th and Allen at 10:30 a.m. This resulted in a loss of water service at the courthouse downtown. The courthouse was evacuated after the City Manager of Kansas City asked that all buildings of 4 or more stories be closed for safety reasons. Water service has now been restored.

6 PERFECTION OF PROPOSED ORDINANCES AND REPORTS OF COMMITTEE

3038 Health and Justice Committee moved to perfect.

Terry Young objects to the consent agenda.

Terry Young, County Legislator, said she will vote no on this Ordinance. Only a couple of studies have been done and they have not found a decrease in gun crime after a gun buy-back. This is not an appropriate use of \$30,000.00 out of the Health Fund especially since we have no statistics that show us this is actually making a dent in gun crime.

Dan Tarwater, County Legislator, said he will also vote no on this Ordinance. Gun buy-back programs have not been proven to work. The guns you get at these programs usually don't work and these are not the guns we want off the street.

Terry Young moved to perfect Ordinance #3038, appropriating \$30,000.00 from the unappropriated surplus of the 2000 Health Fund for the Gun Buy-Back Program to be administered by the Southern Christian Leadership Conference requesting the support of the County Legislature for this program, and authorizing the County Executive to execute a contract with Southern Christian Leadership Conference.
