The Agreement governs connectivity and the exchange of information between the KCPD and the County. There is no additional cost associated with this agreement. The Jackson County Detention Center, requires continuous, uninterrupted access to Tiburon and CJIS data in order to carry out its mission for the citizens of Jackson County, Missouri Consequently, it is requested the Jackson County Legislature authorize execution of the Information Exchange Agreement.
