Pete Levi, President Greater Kansas City Chamber of Commerce, thanked the County Legislature for their time and effort in this process to keep the Chiefs and Royals in this community for the next 25 years. As announced yesterday, with the installation of the rolling roof the Superbowl in the year 2015 will be held at Arrowhead Stadium. Resolution #15814 reflects some of the discussions that have taken place in the business community. Since Question #2 deals with the imposition of the use tax, most of which is paid by the business community, there was much discussion about the tax and how it would be used. The Chamber and other organizations in the community have been working long and hard to keep the teams in Kansas City and to make the improvements. This is the reason the Greater Kansas City Chamber of Commerce Board unanimously endorsed Question #1 and Question #2. During the course of the discussion, there was thought given to other ways in which the passage of Question #2 and the construction of the rolling roof might benefit the community. The resolution states that two-thirds of the naming rights associated with the rolling roof would be put in a fund with the Greater Kansas City Community Foundation and that fund would be used for Jackson County residents for health care, youth and child development purposes. This provides a new stream of revenue to deal with some important issues facing the county. It also shows the great commitment of the Hunt family to Kansas City and to the successful completion of this project. He thinks the passage of Resolution #15814 would build greater support within the business community and the community in general for the passage of Question #1 and #2.

Dan Tarwater, County Legislator, gave credit to the business community who is behind this 100% and said he appreciated all the help from Pete Levi. Being able to have money go back into the community, while cuts are being made on the State level, will be a benefit for everyone.

Henry C. Rizzo said we appreciate this commitment by the business community and the Chamber.

Scott Burnett, County Legislator, said he along with Chairman Rizzo and Dan Tarwater attended the St. Patrick's Day kick off today. Each year the Jackson County Legislature appropriates \$7,000.00 to help with the St. Patrick's Day parade. He said before the kick off event there was a silent auction. His friend Dennis Waits is a huge sports fan and has talked so much about Jose Lima. Scott presented Dennis with a ball autographed by Jose Lima that he purchased from the auction.
