



AMENDMENT #03 TO CONTRACT #KQ200047823

CONTRACT TITLE: Violent Death and Overdose Death Surveillance

CONTRACT PERIOD: September 1, 2021 through August 31, 2022

The Department of Health and Senior Services hereby increases the above referenced contract; therefore Section 1.1 is hereby deleted in its entirety and replaced with revised Section 1.1 as follows:

- 1.1 The contract amount shall not exceed \$34,750.00 for the period of September 1, 2021 through August 31, 2022.

In addition, the Department of Health and Senior Services desires to amend the above-referenced contract in accordance with the following:

1. Delete paragraph 5.2 in its entirety and replace with the revised paragraph 5.2 as follows:
 - 5.2 The Department will pay the Contractor a firm, fixed price of \$30 for each submitted complete OD2A case and upon approval of all required reports and invoices. The total amount for all OD2A cases shall not exceed \$8,250.00.

All other terms, conditions and provisions of the above referenced contract shall remain the same and apply hereto.
