RESOLUTION #17890, May 7, 2012

INTRODUCED BY Fred Arbanas, County Legislator

WHEREAS, by Resolution 17860 dated March 19, 2012, the Legislature did award eight-year leases for the planting and harvesting of hay and crops on County park land, under the terms and conditions of Invitation to Bid No. 17-12; and,

WHEREAS, bidder Robert Hertzog of Greenwood, MO, was awarded leases on several crops located at Longview Lake and was awarded a lease for harvesting of hay at Fleming Park; and,

WHEREAS, Mr. Hertzog has now indicated that he would like to withdraw certain parts of his bid for the Longview Lake crop harvesting and he is declining the bid award for the harvesting of hay at Fleming Park; and,

WHEREAS, after reviewing Mr. Hertzog's request, the Director of Finance and Purchasing recommends that fields 7 and 11 included in the Invitation to Bid No. 17-12 be removed, resulting in a revised bid of \$14,190.00 as payment for crop harvesting at Longview Lake;

and,

WHEREAS, the Director further recommends that the bid for hay harvesting at Fleming Park be re-awarded to Joseph Hand of Holden, MO, in the amount of \$2,828.00, as the second highest bid submitted for hay harvesting at Fleming Park under Invitation to Bid 17-12; now therefore,




BE IT FURTHER RESOLVED, that award for crop harvesting at Longview Lake be revised as recommended by the Director of Finance and Purchasing; and,



It has come to the attention of the Parks and Recreation Department the Robert Hertzog of Greenwood, MO would like to withdraw certain parts of his bid that he feels would not be suitable for Hay/Crop Harvesting as follows:</p> <p>Longview Lake Crops Bid: Fields 7 and 11, resulting in a new amount of \$14,190.00 being paid to the County annually; and</p> <p>Fleming Park Hay Bid: The Parks and Recreation Department would like to re-award this portion of the Contract to Joseph Hand of Holden, MO in the amount of \$2,828.00 annually paid to the County.</p> <p>Pursuant to Section 1054.6 of the Jackson County Code, the Director of Finance and Purchasing recommends the partial rescinding of award to Robert Hertzog and re-award of a portion of this contract to Joseph Hand as the next best proposal submitted.</p>





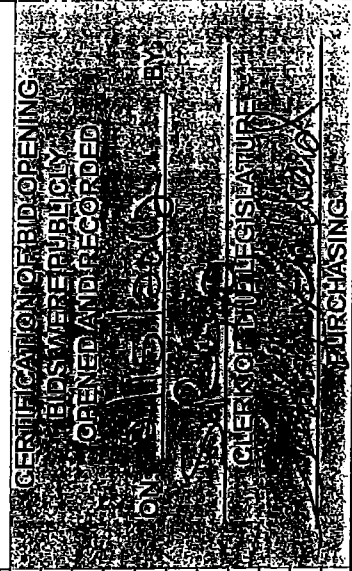

Re: Request to amend Resolution 17860 – Bid No. 17-12 Eight Year Hay/Crop Lease

The Parks & Recreation Department requests that an RLA be submitted to amend Resolution 17860 for Bid No. 17-12 as follows:

- 1) Robert Hertzog was awarded the Longview Lake crops bid. In Mr. Hertzog's bid, he requested that field 11 be omitted because, it had not been in crop production and unsuitable for converting to farm ground. This omission was not taken into consideration when the bid was awarded. He has further requested that field 7 be omitted for the same reason. The acreage in fields 11 and 7 equal a total of 73 acres and therefore, the revised acreage for this area would be 129 acres. Mr. Hertzog's bid for the Longview Lake – crop was \$110 per acre. The annual payment per year would now be \$14,190. The Department recommends that the price per year of \$22,220 for the Longview Lake crops be deleted and replaced with \$14,190.
- 2) Robert Hertzog was awarded the Fleming Park – Lake Jacomo hay bid. Mr. Hertzog has notified the Department that he is declining the bid award for Fleming Park – Lake Jacomo hay lease. The Department would recommend that the bid for this area be awarded to the next highest bidder, Joseph Hand of Holden, Missouri with a bid of \$2,828. Mr. Hand was also awarded the hay ground in Landahl Park, Fleming Park – Blue Springs Lake and Longview Lake. The Department recommends that Robert Hertzog be removed as the bidder and replaced with Joseph Hand of Holden, Missouri with a bid of \$2,828.
