WHEREAS, various County departments are in need of temporary personnel services for various positions; and,

WHEREAS, the Director of Finance and Purchasing has solicited written proposals on Request for Proposals No. 25-007 for the furnishing of temporary personnel services for use by various County departments; and,

WHEREAS, a total of one thousand five hundred fifty-one (1551) notifications were distributed and thirty-two (32) responses were received and evaluated; and,

WHEREAS, following evaluation of the proposals received, the Department of Finance and Purchasing has recommended that the contract be split and awarded to the bidders submitting the lowest and best bid for each classification of temporary positions; and,

WHEREAS, award as recommended would result in awards to the following bidders:

WHEREAS, this award is made on an as needed basis and does not obligate Jackson County to pay any specific amount, with availability of funds for specific positions subject to annual appropriation, with an estimated annual spending of \$100,000.00; now therefore,

BE IT RESOLVED by the County Legislature of Jackson County, Missouri, that awards under the terms and conditions of RFP No. 25-007 be made as recommended by the Director of Finance and Purchasing, and that the Director be, and is hereby authorized to execute for the County any documents necessary to the accomplishment of the award, including the subsequent options for extension; and,

BE IT FURTHER RESOLVED that the Department of Finance and Purchasing is authorized to make all payments, including final payment on the contracts, to the extent that sufficient appropriations to the using spending agency are contained in the then current Jackson County budget.

Effective Date: This Resolution shall be effective immediately upon its passage by a majority of the Legislature.
