5 COMMUNICATIONS AND REPORTS OF THE COUNTY EXECUTIVE

Katheryn Shields, County Executive, said Jackson County has a one million dollar state grant to assist with the historic courthouse on the Square restoration project.

John Shortall, construction manager with Universal Construction, gave an update on the restoration project at the historic courthouse on the Square in Independence, Missouri.

Katheryn Shields reported that the stadium bill received first passage from the Senate. The bill would provide the Harry S Truman Sports Complex with funds necessary to renovate and expand the Royals and Chiefs Stadiums. It is part of a comprehensive effort to provide the teams with three hundred million in funding for stadium renovation that will help ensure that major league sports remain in Jackson County. The bill need to pass in the House of Representatives and then be signed by the Governor. If this happens, the bi-state issue will be placed on the November 2002 ballot.

Katheryn Shields asked the County Legislature to vote affirmatively on the storm debris removal resolution that is before them today. She said if the resolution was not passed today she would contact FEMA and ask them to extend the deadline.

Katheryn Shields gave a summary of events that led to the Ed Severeid leaving his position in the Assessment Department. She reported that the State Tax Commission will conduct a study on the real estate and personal property assessments in Jackson County and report back to the Administration. She said the MIS Department and the software vendor have reviewed the software used by the Assessment Department and found that it was totaling the assessments properly. The National Association of Assessors will also conduct a study and give a report on their findings.

Katheryn Shields said she has looked at the first two reports from Mr. Severeid and would be happy to discuss questions arising from them. However, she has not seen the third report, but she would review it and be ready to answer questions.

Victor E. Callahan, Chairman, suggested that the Finance and Audit Committee have a hearing to discuss the Severeid reports.

Katheryn Shields requested that the meeting be held after May 17th as she was traveling to Jefferson City for the stadium legislation.

Victor E. Callahan said that would be fine.
