Sole Source Justification for Southern Folger

The Department of Corrections utilities a proprietary system for security electronics. This system was installed in 1984 by Southern Folger (predecessor company) and they have been the company that has provided updates, support, training, and changes to the system. No other company can provide this service as it is a proprietary system.

As authorized by prior Ordinance, the Department of Corrections is partnering with the City of Kansas City, Missouri and the Kansas City Police Department to expand jailing services. As authorized by prior award, the bulk of the construction will be performed by Wilson Group.

In order to integrate the new construction with the existing security electronics and master control, it is necessary that Southern Folger provide equipment, engineering, and installation as outlined on the attached scope.

The Department has in the past sought support from other entities and none can provide this type of support without replacing the entire system.

D. Warranty

1. Equipment and manufacturing workmanship are warranted against defects for a period of one (1) year after installation. Warranty is limited to repair or replacement of equipment deemed to have failed under conditions of normal use and excludes failures attributable to misuse, vandalism, or lightning.

E. Contract Execution

- Our proposal is based on execution of a purchase agreement, which will incorporate this proposal in its entirety. As a supplier, SFDEC will not be bound by the General Conditions.

- 4. We will require an executed purchase agreement, from you, prior to performing any work, including submittals. We will begin submittals with an initial letter of

- "Intent to Purchase" with a notice to proceed until we receive your executed purchase agreement.
- 5. Payment terms will be net 30.
