Re: Frito Bid Justification.

At the end of last year, we were buying our chips for the marinas from US Foods. Here are some of the issues that impacted the marinas in a negative way.

- 1) US Foods has only one size of chip available, and it is a vending size bag.
- 2) Many of the chips did not have the bell mark (pre-priced on label) and some of the chips said "not for resale" on the bag.
- The selection of product was limited both by the supply and the quantity we had to buy of each type of chip. If you wanted to sell 2 different types of chips, we had to buy 288 bags (144 of each type).
- 4) There were no large or party size bags of chips available, no dips or cookies that Frito Lay provides.
- We had to order a box of 144 chips of one single kind. The marinas did their best to share, but this lead to car/truck trips back and forth from site to site. Also, we experienced loss when we could not sell the entire box of chips before they went out of date.

I believe buying Chips from Frito Lay offers advantages and solutions to the above problems.

- 1) Frito Lay visits each marina weekly, to restock shelves. They provide the display rack and the display is done by a professional who knows what bags are selling best, and where they should be placed on the self.
- 2) Frito Lay ensures we do not have loss due to out of date products.
- 3) Frito Lay offers a wide variety of sizes and products, which includes nuts, cookies and dips.
- 4) We only pay for what we sell, all remaining product is picked up at the end of the season.
- 5) Frito Lays offers us the specials and new product as they enter the market. Also if a product is not selling, they pick it up and issue us credit.
- 6) All Frito Lays products are bell marked, which means prices are consistent at all county sites, and with the outside market.
