## Notes to County:

Jackson County has averaged =670K minutes per month over the last 12 months.

CenturyLink proposes 55.3% commission as a 'base offer' (regardless of minutes).

 ${\it Century Link proposes 56.6\% commission if minutes per month average at least 650 K for 4 consecutive months.}$ 

CenturyLink proposes 58.6% commission if minutes per month average at least 700K for 4 consecutive months.

With an elasticity of only 20% applied to current average monthly minutes, County is realizing over 800K in minutes per month.

Fee revenue estimates remain unaffected by elasticity.
