WHEREAS, due to a miscommunication between County offices, Resolution 17371 was drafted with erroneous fiscal information, which must be corrected; and,

		Background: The Anti-Drug Sales Tax fund authorizes the County to execute agreements and contracted service for the purpose of providing substance abuse treatment, prevention, grant match, and other anti-drug initiatives in the community.				
	Several meetings were conducted between COMBAT, DARE officers, and the respective Chief of Police of various departments, during which several different funding allocations were examined and discussed. Final consensus was reached that the funding allocation formula be based upon the number of students enrolled in core classes (either 5 th or 6 th grade plus one middle school grade).
