REQUEST SUMMARY	Mid-America Regional Council (MARC) has administered the nine county regional 9-1-1 system since 1983 in the Kansas City area. In 1995, counties in the region entered into a 9-1-1 Interlocal Cooperation Agreement, formalizing the cooperation among governments related to the emergency telephone system. The agreement implemented a modernization of the equipment used by public safety answering points. It also established a policy on sharing the costs for the operations, administration and maintenance costs of the 9-1-1 system on a per capita basis. Additionally, an oversight policy and coordinating committee were established by the Interlocal Agreement. Recently, the document has been updated to add Miami County as a full member of the system and also to correctly identify the newly created Cass County Emergency Services Board in the agreement. The updated						
CLEARANCE	agreement has been approved by both the Public Safety Communications Board and the MARC Board.
