Background: The Anti-Drug Sales Tax fund authorizes the County to execute agreements and contracted service for the purpose of providing substance abuse treatment, prevention, grant match, and other anti-drug initiatives in the community. Exhibit A indicates the county department and the outside agencies that the Jackson County Drug Commission is recommending funding in 2012 to provide D.A.R.E. and/or D.A.R.Elike services in Jackson County.

		Several meetings were conducted between COMBAT, DARE officers, and the respective Chief of Police of the various departments, during which several different funding allocations were examined and discussed. Final consensus was reached that the funding allocation formula be based upon the number of students enrolled in the core classes (either 5 th or 6 th grade plus one middle school grade). Funding recommendations were presented to the Jackson County Drug Commission on January 18, 2012, with the recommendation that the funding recommendation in Exhibit A be presented to the Jackson County Legislature.
