5 COMMUNICATIONS AND REPORTS OF THE COUNTY EXECUTIVE

Janet Colt, Manager of Administration, gave a report on the damage sustained by the flood. Reports are still being filed with the Public Works Department and FEMA is coming in to work with them tomorrow to go over damaged areas. So far the estimate exceeds \$115,000.00. Debris clearance will be about \$25,000.00. Some roads had minor erosion which should cost about \$42,000.00. The most significant damage to our parks occurred at Adair Park. Other damage was reported at Lake Jacomo, Little Blue Trace Park, Hill Park, and Wood Lake dam. The county also helped Greenwood put up baracades where a bridge washed out and we helped Oak Grove put up signs to close Gillespie Road which was under water. All roads are now reopen.
