Katheryn Shields, County Executive, mentioned that on Saturday, November 2, 1996, Kansas City, Missouri's Household Hazardous Waste Drop Off Site opened on Front Street. Hours of operation are Wednesday through Sunday, 8:30 a.m. - 5:00 p.m. It is available to residents of Kansas City at no cost and also to residents of Jackson County who live in the unincorporated areas. The 1997 County budget includes money to allow Jackson County residents to use the site. Blue Springs and Independence have also signed the contract and other municipalities will participate in the future. This drop off site is for paint, pesticides, clorox, etc. to eliminate its disposal into the environment. It would cost \$50.00 per carload if we were not a participant in this program. Lee's Summit has received a grant to open a satellite site. Also, a van will be purchased so they can schedule pickups in the area.
