WHEREAS, the Department of Finance and Purchasing issued Request for Qualifications (RFQ) No. 40-20 for trail design and engineering services; and,

WHEREAS, pursuant to section 1054.6 of the Jackson County Code, the Director of Finance and Purchasing recommends the award of a twelve-month term and supply

contract, with one twelve-month option to extend, for trail planning, design, and engineering services to McClure Engineering of North Kansas City, MO, as the best proposal received; and,

WHEREAS, this award is made on an as needed basis and does not obligate Jackson County to pay any specific amount, with the availability of funds for specific purchases subject to annual appropriation; now therefore,


