

ADDENDUM TO AGREEMENT FOR DISTRIBUTION OF CARES ACT FUNDS

This Addendum to the Agreement for Distribution of CARES Act Funds ("Addendum"), entered into this 28th day of December, 2020, by and between the undersigned Jackson County, Missouri ("County"), and the undersigned Recipient ("Recipient") an entity which operates within said County (collectively the "Parties").

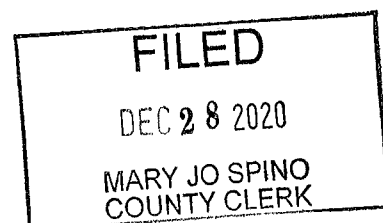
WITNESSETH:

WHEREAS, the County and Recipient entered into an Agreement for Distribution of CARES Act Funds dated July 13, 2020 ("the Prior Agreement"), whereunder County agreed to provide for reimbursement of certain COVID-19 related expenses; and,

WHEREAS, the Parties now desire to increase the maximum sum available for reimbursement under the Prior Agreement.

NOW THEREFORE, in consideration of the foregoing and the terms and provisions herein contained, County and Recipient respectively promise, covenant and agree with each other as follows:


1. Except as expressly provided herein, all provisions of the Prior Agreement shall remain in full force and effect pursuant to its terms.
2. The maximum sum to be paid by County to Recipient shall be increased by the amount of \$153,157.00 for a new maximum total of \$248,091.00 in accordance with the budget attached hereto as Exhibit A.
3. The First Addendum shall be effective as of March 1, 2020, and shall remain in effect, together with the Prior Agreement, until December 30, 2020.
4. This Addendum to Agreement, together with the Prior Agreement, incorporates the entire understanding and agreement of the parties.



This Executive Summary outlines the expenses incurred by the Central Jackson County Fire Protection District since April 13, 2020 in our response to the COVID-19 crisis. The backfill figures outlined below are date ranged from 4/13/2020 – 10/18/2020. As per the previous Jackson County's relief payment of \$94,933.92 on 9/17/2020 the District has prepared a line item summary as submitted before. It is my goal and assurance to you that no fun have been requested in duplicate from the District's prior submission. I have highlighted below the expenses within the 5 functional areas outlined in the CARES ACT of 2020.

Virtual Government Operations	\$10,435.88
Medical Treatment Cost of Emergency Workers	\$4,704.00
Backfill Wage Expense	\$90,403.72
Personal Protective Equipment (PPE)	\$31,337.35
Cleaning & DECON	\$16,275.60
Grand Total	\$153,156.55

The District's first submission to the County was followed with a 400-page detailed explanation of the cost which included payroll records, PO's, and receipts. For this submission, this documentation is being prepared as well and this documentation should be completed by December 15th.
