**TITLE:** Awarding the East Helmig Road Bridge Reconstruction contract, JCPW 3215, Federal Project No. BRO-B048 (60), to Radmacher Brothers Excavating Company, Inc., Pleasant Hill Missouri under the terms and conditions of the Invitation to Bid 24-002.

### SUMMARY:

The County entered into an agreement with MoDOT to fund the construction of bridge improvements on South Helmig Road in the Off System Bridge Program (BRO). This program provides 80% funding on eligible costs for the project. The Local Entity is responsible for the 20% match. MoDOT has approved using our soft match credit for the match, which results in 100% federal funding for the construction of this bridge.

The County entered into an agreement with TREKK Design Group (Ord. 5602) to prepare the Project Manual and Contract Documents for Bid No. ITB 24-002. The work on the South Helmig Road Bridge Reconstruction contract includes the removal of an existing double-cell culvert and the construction of a new double cell 10' x 8' cast-in-place reinforced concrete box culvert, and minor reshaping of the roadway shoulders.

Advertisements were posted by MoDOT on their RFP website, by the Purchasing Division of the Finance Department on the County's website, and on the "Bonfire" website. Construction documents were viewed by five (5) possible bidders. One (1) bid was submitted on March 13, 2024 at 2:00 PM. The summary of the bids are as follows:

The Engineer's Estimate for the project was \$ 624,364.00.

Pursuant to Section 1054.6 of the Jackson County Code, Chapter 10 Purchasing, the Director of Public Works and the Director of Finance and Purchasing recommend that the contract be awarded to Radmacher Brothers Excavating Company, Inc. (Pleasant Hill, MO), being the lowest and best bidder.

We request that:

1. A Resolution be prepared authorizing the County Executive to execute this construction contract with Radmacher Brothers Excavating Company, Inc. (Pleasant Hill, MO).
2. The Director of Finance and Purchasing be authorized to encumber funds to cover the costs of this contract.
3. The Director of Public Works be authorized to approve adjustments in the construction contract, to the extent that there will be no further funding obligation by the County.

All bids must be submitted through the Bonfire Portal at <https://jacksongov.bonfirehub.com> before 2:00 P.M. (prevailing local time) on **March 5, 2024**.

(1) **PROPOSED WORK:** The proposed work, hereinafter called the work, includes:

Removal of the existing cast-in-place culvert and the installation of a double 10' x 8' cast-in-place box culvert, including end sections. Additional work tasks includes reshaping of the roadway shoulders and placement of rock blanket around the wingwalls to prevent erosion.

(2) **COMPLIANCE WITH CONTRACT PROVISIONS:** The Bidder, having examined and being familiar with the local conditions affecting the work, and with the contract, contract documents, including the current version of the Missouri Highways and Transportation Commission's "Missouri Standard Specifications for Highway Construction, 2023", and "Missouri Standard Plans for Highway Construction, 2023", their revisions, and the request for bid, including appendices, the special provisions and plans, hereby proposes to furnish all labor, materials, equipment, services, etc., required for the performance and completion of the work. All references are to the Missouri Standard Specifications for Highway Construction, as revised, unless otherwise noted.

These supplemental bidding documents contain all current revisions to the bound printed versions and have important legal consequences. It shall be conclusively presumed that they are in the Bidder's possession, and they have been reviewed and used by the Bidder in the preparation of any bid submitted on this project.

Please note that within the above-listed documents, the term "Commission" shall be replaced with the term, "Jackson County Public Works", and the term "Engineer" is a reference to the County.

The contracting authority for this contract is Jackson County Public Works.

(3) **PERIOD OF PERFORMANCE:** If the Bid is accepted, the Bidder agrees that work shall be diligently prosecuted at such rate and in such manner as, in the judgment of the Engineer, is necessary for the completion of the work within the time specified as follows in accordance with Sec 108:

(4) **LIQUIDATED DAMAGES:** The bidder agrees that, should the bidder fail to complete the work in the time specified or such additional time as may be allowed by the engineer under the contract, the amount of liquidated damages to be recovered in accordance with Sec 108 shall be as follows:

Liquidated damages: \$950 per day (see General Conditions GC-49 and Special Conditions SC-49).

(5) **BID GUARANTY**: The Bidder shall submit a Bid Guaranty with the Bid meeting the requirements of Sec. 102 of the Missouri Standard Specifications for Highway Construction. A sample project Bid Bond form is included in the project manual. The Bidder shall mark the box below to identify the type of Bid Guaranty.

(6) **CERTIFICATIONS FOR FEDERAL JOBS**: By signing and submitting this Bid, the Bidder makes the certifications appearing in Sec. 102.18.1 (regarding affirmative action and equal opportunity), Sec. 102.18.2 (regarding disbarment, eligibility, indictments, convictions, or civil judgments), Sec. 102.18.3 (regarding anti-collusion), and Sec. 102.18.4 (regarding lobbying activities). Any necessary documentation is to accompany the bid submission, as required by these sections. As provided in Sec. 108.13, the contracting authority may terminate the contract for acts of misconduct, which includes but is not limited to fraud, dishonesty, and material misrepresentation or omission of fact within the bid submission.

(7) **ANTIDISCRIMINATION**: The Contracting Authority hereby notifies all Bidders that it will affirmatively insure that in any Contract entered into pursuant to this advertisement, businesses owned and controlled by socially and economically disadvantaged individuals will be afforded full opportunity to submit bids in response to this invitation and will not be discriminated against on the grounds of race, color, religion, creed, sex, age, ancestry, or national origin in consideration for an award.

(8) **FEDERAL AND STATE INSPECTION**: The Federal Government is participating in the cost of construction of this project. All applicable Federal laws, and the regulations made pursuant to such laws, shall be observed by the contractor, and the work will be subject to the inspection of the appropriate State or Federal Agency in the same manner as provided in Sec 105.10 of the Missouri Standard Specifications for Highway Construction with all revisions applicable to this bid and contract.

(9) **PREVAILING WAGE (FEDERAL AND STATE)**: This contract requires payment of the prevailing hourly rate of wages for each craft or type of work required to execute the contract as determined by the Missouri Department of Labor and Industrial Relations, and requires adherence to a schedule of minimum wages as determined by the United States Department of Labor. For work performed anywhere on this project, the contractor and the contractor's subcontractors shall pay the higher of these two applicable wage rates. The applicable state wage rates for this contract are detailed in "Annual Wage Order No. 67", that is attached to this bidding document. The applicable federal wage rates for this contract are the effective Davis-Bacon federal wage rates posted the tenth day before the bid opening date and are attached herein.

These supplemental Bidding Documents have important legal consequences. It shall be conclusively presumed that they are in the Bidder's possession, and they have been reviewed and used by the Bidder in the preparation of any Bid submitted on this project.

(10) **WORKER ELIGIBILITY REQUIREMENTS**: Execution of the construction contract for this project is dependent upon the awarded Bidder providing an Affidavit of Compliance AND E-Verify Memorandum-of-Understanding (MOU) between the Bidder and Department of Homeland Security to the Contracting Authority as required by section 285.530 RSMo. The cover page and signature page of the E-Verify MOU and the Affidavit must be submitted prior to award of this contract.

All Bidders must also be enrolled in the E-Verify Program, and include their MOU prior to contract execution. This requirement also applies to subcontractors and contract labor, but this contract only requires submittal of the verification documents for the prime contractor. It is the prime contractor’s responsibility to verify the worker eligibility of their subcontractors in order to protect their own company from liability as required by section 285.530 RSMo.

**(11) OSHA TEN HOUR TRAINING REQUIREMENTS:** Missouri Law, 292.675 RSMO, requires any awarded contractor and its subcontractor(s) to provide a ten-hour Occupational Safety and Health Administration (OSHA) Construction Safety Program (or a similar program approved by the Missouri Department of Labor and Industrial Relations as a qualified substitute) for their on-site employees (laborers, workmen, drivers, equipment operators, and craftsmen) who have not previously completed such a program and are directly engaged in actual construction of the improvement (or working at a nearby or adjacent facility used for construction of the improvement). The awarded contractor and its subcontractor(s) shall require all such employees to complete this ten-hour program, pursuant to 292.675 RSMO, unless they hold documentation on their prior completion of said program. Penalties, for Non-Compliance include contractor forfeiture to the Contracting Authority in the amount of \$2,500, plus \$100 per contractor and subcontractor employee for each calendar day such employee is employed beyond the elapsed time period for required program completion under 292.675 RSMO.

**(12) BUY AMERICA REQUIREMENTS:** Construction contracts shall assure compliance with Section 165 of the Surface Transportation Assistance Act of 1982, Section 337 of the Surface Transportation and Uniform Relocation Assistance Act of 1987, 23 CFR 635.410, and the Bipartisan Infrastructure Law (2021) Build America, Buy America Act Publication L. No. 117-58 regarding Buy America provisions on the procurement of foreign products and materials. On all contracts involving Federal-aid, all products of iron, steel, or a coating of steel which are incorporated into the work must have been manufactured in the United States. Construction materials consisting primarily of non-ferrous metals, plastic and polymer-based products, glass, lumber, or drywall also require Buy America certification. Cement and cementitious materials; aggregates such as stone, sand, or gravel; or aggregate binding agents or additives are excluded from this requirement. In addition, manufactured products are currently exempted under the 1983 waiver from FHWA. The Contracting Authority may allow minimal amounts of these materials from foreign sources, provided the cost does not exceed 0.1 percent of the contract sum or \$2,500, whichever is greater. (16) **SUBCONTRACTOR DISCLOSURE**: Requirements contained within Sec 102.7.8 of the Missouri Standard Specification for Highway Construction shall be waived for this contract.

(17) **PROJECT AWARD**: This project will be awarded to the lowest, responsive, responsible Bidder.

(18) **MATERIALS INSPECTIONS**: All technicians who perform, or are required by the FHWA to witness, such sampling and testing shall be deemed as qualified by virtue of successfully completing the requirements of EPG 106.18 Technician Certification Program, for that specific technical area.

(19) **PRIME CONTRACTOR REQUIREMENTS**: The limitation in Sec 108.1.1 of the Missouri Standard Specifications for Highway Construction that "the contractor's organization shall perform work amounting to not less than 30 percent of the total contract cost" is waived for this contract. Instead, the less restrictive terms of the Federal Highway Administration's rule at Title 23 Code of Federal Regulations (CFR) § 635.116(a) shall apply, so that the contractor must perform project work with its own organization equal to and not less than 30 percent of the total original contract price. Second-tier subcontracting will not be permitted on this contract. All other provisions in Sec 108.1.1 et seq. of the Missouri Standard Specifications for Highway Construction shall remain in full force and effect, and shall continue to govern the contractor and its subcontractors, in accordance with the provisions of Title 23 CFR § 635.116.


