WHEREAS, following evaluation of the proposals submitted, the Director of Finance and

Purchasing recommends the award to Midwest ADP of Independence, MO, as the lowest and best bid; and,

WHEREAS, pursuant to section 1054.6, <u>Jackson County Code</u>, 1984, the Director of Finance and Purchasing recommends the award of the contract to Midwest ADP of Independence, MO, under the terms and conditions of Request for Proposals No. 46-11 as the lowest and best bidder meeting specifications as set out in the attached recapitulation and analysis; now therefore,

BE IT RESOLVED by the County Legislature of Jackson County, Missouri, that the award be made as recommended by the Director of Finance and Purchasing and that the Director be and hereby is authorized to execute for the County any documents necessary for the accomplishment of the award.

The Jackson County Municipal Court has been operating since 2008 to handle County ordinance violations issued by the Jackson County Sheriff's Office. Located in the Independence Courthouse Annex, the Court holds 2-3 dockets per month and processes approximately 10,000 cases monthly.

Recently, the County partnered with the 16th Circuit Court to divert "Driving While Revoked" offenses of violators who have already received four (4) previous DWR convictions to the Jackson County Municipal Court in order to assist these offenders in their efforts to reinstate their driving privileges. The County issued RFP 46-11, soliciting proposals from qualified firms to provide services associated with a Driving While Revoked diversion program. The purpose of this program is to break the cycle of DWR charges instigated by a single DWR charge if the defendant is otherwise responsible with his/her driving record.

Two responses to RFP 46-11 were received. While the review team, consisting of Amiee Wenson, Natalie Tann, Candy Messenbrink and Judge Garry Helm, believed that both Midwest ADP and Northland Dependency Services were qualified to deliver this program, it was determined that Midwest ADP brings the most experience and expertise to the table. Pricing was also a consideration. Northland Dependency Services' proposal included a \$25 intake fee in addition to a \$25 per month service charge. Considering that we estimate it would take an average of 6 months for a defendant to work through the program, Midwest ADP's flat charge of \$150 per defendant is a lower cost.

At this time, we would like to proceed with a contract with Midwest ADP for the DWR Diversion program. We estimate that approximately 50 defendants would participate in the program on an annual basis. Midwest ADP provided a cost of \$150.00 per participant in their proposal, and therefore the contract would be for an amount not to exceed \$7,500.

09. **PRICING**

Midwest ADP currently provides DWS/DWR diversions for \$200.00 to self-paying participants who are deemed eligible by the Assistant Jackson County Prosecutors Mr. Jeff Keal and Ms. Melissa Howard.

Midwest ADP will provide the scope of services outlined in this RFP to Jackson County for a contract price of \$150.00 per participant for those participants whose fees are paid for by Jackson County.

Midwest ADP intends on continuing to charge \$200.00 for self-paying DWS/DWR diversion participants.
