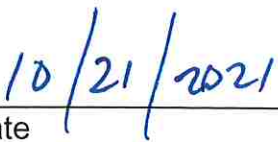

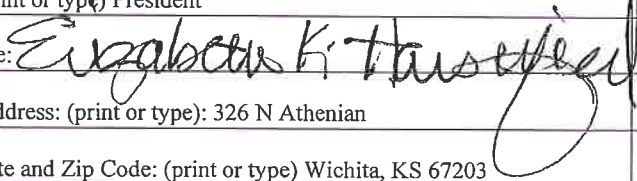

INTERGOVERNMENTAL COOPERATIVE AGREEMENT

THIS INTERGOVERNMENTAL COOPERATIVE AGREEMENT entered into this _____ day of _____, 2021, by and between Jackson County, Missouri ("the County") and the City of Kansas City, Missouri ("the City"), for a period of twelve months beginning November 1, 2021, and ending October 31, 2022.

WHEREAS, the City serves as the Fiscal Agent for the Kansas City Community Safety Partnership (formerly Kansas City No Violence Alliance), which is a multi-jurisdictional, collaborative initiative to provide services such as rental and housing assistance, education, employment, training, and mental health and substance abuse counseling to at risk individuals, and;

WHEREAS, the Community Safety Partnership's Social Services Department has agreed to furnish staff for this initiative to serve as client advocates.

WHEREAS, the City and the County have agreed to be bound by the provisions hereof;

NOW THEREFORE, in consideration of the foregoing and the terms and provisions herein contained, the County and the City respectively agree as follows:

1. **Services.** The City shall work with the County's Prosecuting Attorney's Office by providing staff for the Kansas City Community Safety Partnership, as is more fully described in the attached Exhibit A and incorporated herein by reference.

2. **Independent Contractor.** The City shall work as an independent contractor and not as an employee of the County. Based upon its expertise and knowledge, the City shall be subject to the direction of the County only as to the type of

services to be rendered and not as to the means and methods for accomplishing the result. The City shall report all earnings received hereunder as gross income and be responsible for its own Federal, State and Local withholding taxes and all other taxes, and operate its business independent of the business of the County, except as required by this Agreement.

3. **Payment.** For services rendered under this Agreement, the County shall pay City a fee of \$78,269.00 upon the execution of this Agreement.

4. **Expenses.** The City shall be responsible for its own expenses related to the services provided under this Agreement.

5. **Duration and Termination.** This Agreement shall be effective as of November 1, 2021, and shall continue through October 31, 2022.

6. **Assignment.** The City agrees, in addition to all other provisions herein, that the City will not assign any portion or the whole of this Agreement without the prior written consent of the County.

7. **Remedies for Breach.** The City agrees to faithfully observe and perform all of the terms and conditions of this Agreement, and failure to do so shall represent and constitute a breach of this Agreement. In such event, the City consents and agrees as follows:

- (1) The County may terminate this Agreement by giving thirty (30) days' notice to City; and,
- (2) The County shall be entitled to seek any available legal remedy and to collect from the City all costs incurred by the County as a result of said breach including reasonable attorney's fees, costs and expenses.

8. **Severability.** If any covenant and other provision of this Agreement is found to be invalid or incapable of being enforced by reason of any rule of law or public policy, all other conditions and provisions of this Agreement shall nevertheless remain in full force and effect and no covenant or provision shall be deemed dependent upon any other covenant or provision unless otherwise expressly stated herein.

9. **Conflict of Interest.** The City warrants that no officer or employee of the County, whether elected or appointed, shall in any manner whatsoever have an interest in or receive any benefit from the profits emoluments of this Agreement.

10. **Employment of Unauthorized Aliens Prohibited.** Pursuant to §285.530.1, RSMo, the City assures that it does not knowingly employ, hire for employment, or continue to employ an unauthorized alien to perform work within the State of Missouri and/or Jackson County, and shall affirm, by sworn affidavit and provision of documentation, its enrollment and participation in a federal work authorization program with respect to the employees working in connection with the contracted services. Further, the City shall sign an affidavit, attached hereto and incorporated herein as Exhibit B, affirming that it does not knowingly employ any person who is an unauthorized alien in connection with the contracted services.

11. **Liability and Indemnification.** No party to this Agreement shall assume any liability for the acts of any other party to this Agreement, its officers, employees or agents and the City shall indemnify, defend and hold the County harmless from any and all claims, liabilities, damages, costs (including reasonable attorney's fees directly related thereto) including but not limited to violation of civil rights and/or bodily injury to

or death of any person and for damage to or destruction of property if and to the extent caused by the negligence, willful misconduct or omissions of the City, its officers, employees or agents during the performance of this Agreement.

12. **Incorporation.** This Agreement incorporates the entire understanding and agreement of the parties hereto.

The City of Kansas City, as fiscal agent for the Kansas City Community Safety Partnership (formerly Kansas City No Violence Alliance), proposes a 2022 (specific term is November 1, 2021 – October 31st, 2022) budget of \$225,328.00 and requests that funds from the Jackson County Prosecutor be dedicated to fulfillment of that budget. The Kansas City Community Safety Partnership Social Services department provides services such as but not limited to: rental and housing assistance, education, employment, training, mental health, and substance abuse counseling to some of Kansas City's most at risk individuals who have been identified as being *close* to violence. Being close to violence may mean that the individual has been a victim or the individual may be at risk of perpetuating violent crime.

Our work also includes fostering trusting and transparent relationships that lead to a reduction in violence by changing the trajectory of the clients' life. We support our clientele through mentoring, counseling, and basic trauma informed care.

We provide home visits to engage individuals to work with us in case management where we can help identify the necessary services they have need of. Currently our department is made up of three Client Advocates and myself as the Director of the department.

If funding was no option, I would staff 10 Client Advocates an office manager, and have onsite mental health counseling. Since that is not our current situation we do the very best we can with what we have. Below is a budget description which only includes salaries and benefits for our four-person team. These figures do not include funding for client deliverables such as rental and utility assistance, food, emergency shelter, education, and employment assistance.

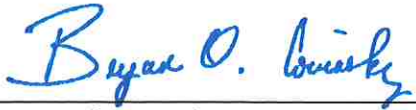

Ma'am,

Practical training, repetition, and experience are the key to saving police officer lives, lives of the citizens, and reducing lawsuits. Long gone are the days of relying on classroom training and limited scenarios firing live ammunition on a makeshift call for service.

The current atmosphere in which demands for more and better training for law enforcement lead the Sheriff's Office to find a suitable solution.

The solution we found was in the VirTra systems V300 firearms simulator. The platform provides the Sheriff's Office, Jackson County Detention Center, and other agencies the ability to train in real to life situations without the use of simunitions or actors. The V300 offers safety, ease of use, and the ability to use it anytime.

In addition, the use of the simulator for deescalation, mentally ill or impaired, and dealing with those with special needs training, gives law enforcement officers opportunities to succeed in their dealings with these groups of people in the real world.

Finally, during research, Stockton (2019)(1) stated, "...simulator training can provide a degree of stress inoculation that allows an officer to function more effectively and to respond rather than impulsively react". This benefit alone gives Jackson County the opportunity to reduce lawsuits due to lack of preparation or panic.

Definitions: The following capitalized words shall mean: “End Users/Buyer” means the organization or person who buys Seller’s Goods and Services. “Goods and Services” means the articles, products, accessories and services to be supplied to Buyer by Seller. “Technology and Intellectual Property Rights” means all patents, registered and unregistered designs, copyright, trademarks, know-how, software, firmware, hardware, systems, components, or assemblies. “Seller” means VirTra, Inc., located at 7970 S Kyrene Rd., Tempe, AZ 85284.

These Sales Terms and Conditions for Direct Sales to End Users/Buyers (“T&C”) apply to Buyer’s purchase of all Goods and Services purchased directly from Seller. Goods and Services sold by Seller are expressly subject to and conditioned upon the T&C set forth herein. By accepting delivery of the Goods and Services, Buyer accepts and is bound to these T&C. Any different or additional terms set forth by, whether in Buyer’s purchase order or another communication, are expressly rejected and will not be binding on Seller unless agreed to in writing by an authorized officer of Seller.

All Sales Final. All sales are final and no returns, refunds or exchanges of the Goods and Services are allowed, except as provided by state or federal law, and, to the returns, refunds or exchanges are required by law, must be preapproved by Seller using their Return Merchandise Authorization (RMA) form.

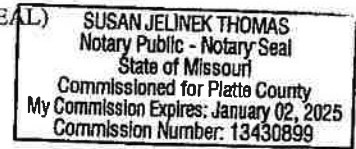

WHEREAS, Resolution No. 20781, dated October 4, 2021, extended the County's mask mandate order (the "Renewed Public Health Order") until November 7, 2021; and,

WHEREAS, the County's COVID-19 cases are declining in eastern Jackson County, Missouri, with an 8% positivity rate which is below the 10% threshold, as reported by the Jackson County Health Department; and,

WHEREAS, according to the COVID dashboard produced by the Mid-America Regional Council, daily average new cases of COVID-19 in eastern Jackson County are well below peak levels reported in August 2021; now therefore,

WHEREAS, Paul is remembered for his vision and dedication as a strong and trusted voice on behalf of the citizens of Missouri; now therefore,

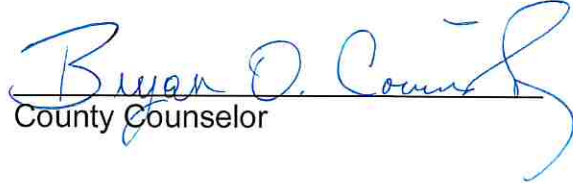
