A RESOLUTION awarding a twelve-month extension to the term and supply contract with Blue Cross and Blue Shield of Kansas City for associate group dental insurance under the terms and conditions of Request for Proposal No.49-16.

RESOLUTION NO. 20005, October 8, 2018

INTRODUCED BY Crystal Williams, County Legislator

WHEREAS, by Resolution 19250, dated September 12, 2016, the Legislature did award a twelve-month term and supply contract, with two twelve-month options to extend, for the furnishing of employee group dental insurance as an employee benefit for use countywide to Blue Cross and Blue Shield of Kansas City, MO, under the terms and condition of Request for Proposal No. 49-16; and,

WHEREAS, the Director of Human Resources recommends the extension of this contract with Blue Cross and Blue Shield; and,

WHEREAS, this extension will provide the same dental benefit options currently provided, with a nine percent increase for the base and buy-up plans and no increase for the DHMO; and,

WHEREAS, the "Family Health" rate has been eliminated for all associates to equalize the County's contribution for associates based on their plan choices; and,

WHEREAS, the total monthly premium costs for 2019 by plan type and rate option are as follows:

WHEREAS, this award is made on an as needed basis and does not obligate the County to pay any specific amount, with the availability of funds subject to annual appropriation; now therefore,

BE IT RESOLVED by the County Legislature of Jackson County, Missouri, that the Director of Finance and Purchasing be and hereby is authorized to execute a twelve-month extension to the term and supply contract with Blue Cross and Blue Shield of Kansas City, MO, for the furnishing of employee group dental insurance and any and all document necessary to the accomplishment of this extension; and,

BE IT FURTHER RESOLVED that the Director of the Department of Finance and Purchasing be and hereby is authorized to make all payments including final payment on the contract, to the extent that sufficient appropriations to the using spending agencies in the then current Jackson County budget.

Effective Date: This Resolution shall be effective immediately upon its passage by a majority of the Legislature.
