The Coronavirus Emergency Supplemental Funding grant from the Department of Justice – Bureau of Justice Assistance applied for by the Sheriff's Office Safety-Security-Technology Unit at the request of County Administration was awarded by the DOJ/BJA, approved by Sheriff Forté, approved by the Legislature, accepted by Executive Frank White, Jr., and funds have been allocated according to the budget details submitted in the grant application.

This memo is requesting your assistance in review and preparation of a Request for Legislative Action to purchase **Two (2) Portable LiveScan Fingerprint Booking Stations w/ Mugshot Capture, and Four (4) MorphoIdent Mobile Solutions**. These items were specifically requested for federal funding in the CESF grant application.

This equipment interfaces with the MULES and NCIC systems for enrollment of Offender and Criminal fingerprints; we are required by the Missouri State Highway Patrol to acquire the equipment using the State Contract for use/interface with MULES/NCIC/CJIS systems using Missouri State Contract #C215091002.

## Section 2. IDEMIA MorphoIDent Mobile Solution

MorphoIDent promotes officer safety with its ease of use and overall intuitiveness, and minimizes training requirements. The MorphoIDent Device ("MorphoIDent") provides excellent visibility – even in direct sunlight – with its large 2-inch LCD screen.

The MorphoIDent captures an individual's fingerprints and submits a data packet to the MorphoMobile Software on the Jackson County Sheriff's Office and Detention Center workstation via the Bluetooth/USB connection.

The MorphoMobile Software generates a Missouri State Highway Patrol (MSHP)-compliant ANSI/NIST file and submits the search request to the MSHP AFIS system for identification. Results are returned to the MorphoMobile application screen and to the MorphoIDent for notification and positive identification, if available.

- ◆ Providing necessary facility resources required for equipment installation and operation including access, space, environmental control, electrical power and networking.
- ◆ To obtain and maintain the required transmission lines and hardware for remote communications to and from the necessary agencies.
- ◆ Obtaining all required authorizations for connecting to the Missouri State Highway Patrol (MSHP) AFIS.

**MorphoDent – Specific:**

- ◆ Data Encryption Certificates to meet FBI CJIS Requirements
- ◆ End-user training
- ◆ Ensuring the required inter-agency agreements are in place between itself and MSHP, local, state and government AFIS
- ◆ Ensuring Jackson County Sheriff's Office and Detention Center provided workstations support at minimum Bluetooth 2.0 or USB 2.0. If USB 2.0, at least one (1) available port is required.
- ◆ Ensuring Jackson County Sheriff's Office and Detention Center workstations are able to connect to the Missouri State Highway Patrol "MULES" system in order to use this device

- ◆ Ensuring Jackson County Sheriff's Office and Detention Center is compliant with CJIS Security requirements.
- ◆ Ensuring that the Wireless Wide Area Network (WWAN) will support either HTTP/HTTPS or SMTP/S-MIME data protocols to exchange data between MorphoMobile and the MSHP AFIS
- ◆ Executing a Memo of Understanding (MOU) with the MSHP for access to the MSHP AFIS and FBI RISC for the purpose of mobile search requests.
- ◆ Installing MorphoMobile Application Software on each Jackson County Sheriff's Office and Detention Center workstation or smart phone, as indicated in the Quick Start Reference Guide
- ◆ Pairing each MorphoDent Terminal with each Jackson County Sheriff's Office and Detention Center provided workstation via Bluetooth or USB, as indicated in the Quick Start Reference Guide
- ◆ Provide the necessary network connectivity between the MSHP LAN and incoming WAN transactions including requisite backend connectivity
- ◆ Testing the MorphoDent Terminal and MorphoMobile Software as per the Quick Start Reference Guide or Installation Guide
- ◆ Battery replacement is handled as a consumable and is outside the scope of warranty and annual maintenance coverage

**Assumptions**

- ◆ In developing this proposal, IDEMIA has made the following assumptions:
- ◆ With the exception of the MSHP AFIS, there are no external interfaces to support which includes but is not limited to records management system, booking system, mugshot system, etc.
- ◆ An inter-agency agreement between Jackson County Sheriff's Office and Detention Center and MSHP will be in place.
- ◆ Jackson County Sheriff's Office and Detention Center will provide all necessary communication to connect to MSHP. This includes, but is not limited to hubs, routers, modems, etc.


