1. Payments mailed should be by personal check, cashier's check, or money order; cash should not be mailed.

5. In the event any personal check or other instrument tendered by Customer for payment under this Agreement is returned unpaid by Customer's financial institution, Customer shall immediately forfeit his or her parking privileges. Customer's parking privileges can only be reinstated when Customer makes the County whole for all costs incurred as a result of the unpaid instrument, including returned check fees, insufficient funds fees, closed account fees, and any other fees and/or costs of a similar nature.

6. Any vehicle parked by Customer in the Facility in a manner not in compliance with the terms of this Agreement is subject to being ticketed and/or towed at the County's discretion. Jurisdiction over the enforcement of parking tickets shall be in the County Municipal Court.
