WHEREAS, notifications were distributed and one bid was received from Waste Management of Kansas, Inc; and,

WHEREAS, the Director of Finance and Purchasing recommends that the contract be awarded to Waste Management of Kansas, Inc, under the terms and conditions of Invitation to Bid 24-096, as the lowest and best bidder, as set forth in the attached recapitulation and analysis; and,

WHEREAS, this award is made on an as needed basis and does not obligate the County to pay any specific amount, with the availability of funds for specific purchases being subject to annual appropriation, with an annual estimated usage of \$112,500.00; now therefore,
