Subject: Riot Control Equipment

Sir,

Currently, the Jackson County Sheriff's Office (JCSO) does not have any riot control equipment to be used during a riot/civil unrest incident should the need arise.

Jackson County is the second most populated county in the State of Missouri. As such, the size and population of the county creates a higher likelihood of a critical incident than most. In addition, there are several key infrastructures within Jackson County. They include several Jackson County Courthouses, Honeywell Government Installation, Lake City Ammunition Plant (a National Strategic Asset), the BP Plant, National Football League (Chief's) and Major League Baseball (Royal's) stadiums, the Sprint Center, the Independence Events Center, several spirit festivals throughout each municipality, several power stations, and many water treatment plants. In addition, the Jackson County Park System ranks 2nd in the nation only to New York's Central Park, and it holds lakes and recreation areas.

Over the past several years the Jackson County Sheriff's Office has participated in several large events including the 2012 MLB All-Star Game, 2014 MLB World Series, the 2014 Bandido's Motorcycle Gang National Rally. It has also been involved in numerous preoperational meetings involving the potential of protestors at Lake City Ammunition Plant.

Due to the current situation in Ferguson, MO, and the high likelihood of violence in and around Ferguson or elsewhere, the need for this equipment is critical.

By obtaining the protective equipment, the Jackson County Sheriff's Office could provide the citizens and visitors of Jackson County and its surrounding jurisdictions assistance and/or protection in a critical incident. In addition, it would be used to assist the agencies which are not able to control an emergency situation in their time of need.

The number one objective of the Sheriff's Office is to take every precaution necessary to assure the safety and well-being of all parties involved including innocent victims, police personnel, and the suspect(s).

Therefore, I would like to request an emergency purchase of the following riot control equipment:
