This ordinance repeals existing county code Section 727. Health Insurance, Former Employees. of Chapter 7. County Personnel.

### Request Summary

This ordinance repeals existing county code Section 727. Health Insurance, Former Employees. The repeal of this section of the code, would eliminate the unintended liability section 727 creates. Section 727 allows for former employees who are vested with the county to buy into the employer provided health plans. Section 727. Health Insurance, Former Employees reads, in the event that the county shall contract for group health insurance for the benefit of any county officers or employees, any such group health insurance contract shall provide for coverage eligibility for any former county employee who is vested in the county employee pension plan established under chapter 15 of this code and who is actually receiving pension benefits under the plan, at the former employee=s own expense, until such time as the former employee is eligible for health insurance coverage under the United States Department of Health and Human Services= Medicare program.
