#### 5 COMMUNICATIONS AND REPORTS OF THE COUNTY EXECUTIVE

Mike Sanders, County Executive, said this is the third year in a row that the Jackson County Drug Task Force has received the Law Enforcement Unit of Year Award for the State of Missouri. Herb Soule, Chief of Police of Sugar Creek, Dan Cummings, Executive Director of the Jackson County Drug Task Force and Mike Sharp, Sheriff of Jackson County, Missouri were present to speak about the Drug Task Force.
