A RESOLUTION authorizing the County Executive to execute a Consulting Services Agreement with R. Ward & Associates, Inc., of Ozark, MO, at a cost to the County not to exceed \$10,141.00.

**RESOLUTION #17667, September 12, 2011** 

INTRODUCED BY Bob Spence, County Legislator

WHEREAS, by Resolution 16871, dated March 30, 2009, the Legislature did urge the Lake Lotawana Sportsmen's Club ("Club") to voluntarily suspend operations due to public safety concerns; and,

WHEREAS, the Club complied with that request and Jackson County retained the services of R. Ward & Associates, Inc., to inspect and prepare a gun range assessment report that included recommendations for operation and construction improvements to the rifle and pistol ranges; and,

WHEREAS, by Resolution 17027, dated October 5, 2009, the Legislature did authorize an agreement with R. Ward & Associates, Inc., to provide consulting services and recommendations for standard operating procedures and construction improvements to the Club's rifle and pistol ranges, at a cost to the County not to exceed \$7,869.91; and,

WHEREAS, R. Ward & Associates partially performed the services requested, but inadvertently the agreement was not executed; and,

WHEREAS, the rifle and pistol range remains closed and the Lake Lotawana Sportsmen's Club recently expressed an interest in submitting revised construction plans and revised standard operating procedures for evaluation by the consultant; and,

WHEREAS, the County now desires to enter into a Consulting Services Agreement with R. Ward & Associates to cover the cost of the work performed in 2009 on the Lake Lotawana Sportsmen's Club rifle and pistol range, to review the Club's revised standard operating procedures and construction plans, and to perform a final on-site inspection with a written evaluation, at a cost to the County not to exceed \$10,141.00; and,

WHEREAS, the Lake Lotawana Sportsmen's Club will reimburse the County for a portion of the services rendered under the contract, in the amount of \$2,270.75; now therefore,

BE IT RESOLVED by the County Legislature of Jackson County, Missouri, that the County Executive be, and is hereby, authorized to execute for the County a Consulting Services Agreement with R. Ward & Associates, Inc., of Ozark, MO, in a form to be approved by the County Counselor; and,

BE IT FURTHER RESOLVED that the Director of Finance and Purchasing is authorized to make all payments, including final payment on the agreement.

Effective Date: This Resolution shall be effective immediately upon its passage by a majority of the Legislature.

REQUEST SUMMARY	Resolution 16871 was adopted on March 30, 2009 urging Lake Lotawana Sportsmen's Club to voluntarily suspend shooting range operations due to public safety concerns so that a qualified gun range safety consultant can be retained to evaluate the rifle and pistol ranges. Jackson County retained the professional services of R. Ward & Associates, Inc. to inspect and prepare a range assessment report that included recommendations for operation and construction improvements to both ranges.				
	R. Ward & Associates, Inc. presented the Range Assessment Report to the County Legislature and a public meeting was held by Public Works Committee on June 22, 2009 to gather public input regarding the report conclusions and recommendations. The Lake Lotawana Sportsmen's Club submitted their Standard Operating Procedures (SOPs) for the ranges and construction design plans for improvements to the ranges.				
	Resolution 17027 was passed on October 5, 2009 authorizing the County Executive to execute an agreement for additional Professional Services as outlined on the attached proposal with R. Ward and Associates, Inc. Additional services include review and comment/recommendation on revised Standard Operating Procedures and construction plans, conduct a final on-site inspection and provide a written evaluation.				
	The consultant performed several of the tasks outlined in the Professional Services agreement authorized in 2009; however, inadvertently the agreement was not fully executed. At the same time, the consultant was given				

	the direction to proceed with the initial plan review and evaluation of the SOPs. This work was complete that portion of the work has yet to be invoiced (\$4,358.56 of the total). The construction plans and SOPs or rejected by the consultant and therefore the Gun Club was told revised plans would be required prior to authorization to proceed, and the subsequent reviews would be charged to the Club under a provision set of the Code of Ordinances Section 5410.3. No design plans or revised SOPs have been submitted to date.  In the recent few months, the Gun Club has expressed an interest in resubmitting plans and revised SOPs. such, the County is requesting authorization to enter into an agreement with Ward & Associates for three purposes: (1) to pay for the work performed in 2009 and not yet paid (\$4,358.56 to be paid by county); (2 pre-authorize the work which will be reimbursed by the Gun Club for second review of revised plans and SOPs (\$2,270.75); and (3) for final inspection of the work upon construction completion (\$3,511.35 to be by county).  Therefore, the Department of Public Works requests that a resolution be prepared re-authorizing the Coun Executive to execute an agreement for additional Professional Services as outlines on the attached propose R. Ward and Associates, Inc. Additional services include review and comment/recommendation on revise Standard Operating Procedures and construction plans, conduct a final on-site inspection and provide a weevaluation.
