

**CENTER FOR RECOVERY HEALTH AND WELLNESS
FUNDING AGREEMENT**

This Funding Agreement for the Center for Recovery Health and Wellness Funding Agreement (the "Agreement") is made and entered into between **Truman Medical Center, Incorporated d/b/a University Health** ("University Health") and **Jackson County, Missouri** ("Jackson County") (collectively, the "Parties").

WHEREAS, in December 2022, Jackson County received \$1,457,685.00 in settlement funds from a class action lawsuit against opioid manufacturers, and Jackson County expects to receive additional funds in the amount of at least \$1,542,315.00 in settlement funds from the lawsuit against opioid manufacturers (collectively, the "Opioid Litigation Funds");

WHEREAS, the opioid epidemic is still a pressing problem in Jackson County, and Jackson County and its residents are in need of a new specialized opioid treatment center;

WHEREAS, University Health is an academic medical center that provides accessible, quality health care to patients in Jackson County regardless of ability to pay;

WHEREAS, University Health intends to renovate an existing facility in its Hospital Hill campus to provide patients with access to opioid treatments and direct care, including psychiatric services, Medications for Addiction Treatment (MAT), case management and peer recovery interventions to address psychosocial determinants of health (the "Center for Recovery Health and Wellness");

WHEREAS, the Jackson County Executive was authorized pursuant to Ordinance No. 5769 introduced on July 17, 2023 and duly passed on August 7, 2023 by the Jackson County Legislature to enter into an agreement with University Health for a new opioid treatment center on University Health's Hospital Hill campus; and

WHEREAS, Jackson County has designated \$3,000,000 from the Opioid Litigation Funds to University Health for the Center for Recovery Health and Wellness pursuant to Ordinance No. 5769.

NOW THEREFORE, in consideration of the mutual benefits to be derived by Jackson County and University Health, the Parties hereby agree as follows:

1. Jackson County will appropriate to University Health \$3,000,000 in Opioid Litigation Funds;
2. University Health will use the \$3,000,000 for its Center for Recovery Health and Wellness, including construction and building renovations.




