5 COMMUNICATIONS AND REPORTS OF THE COUNTY EXECUTIVE

Katheryn Shields, County Executive, gave an update on the Records Department. She said that in the last week six new people have been hired in this department. Three of these new employees have records department experience and a training process will begin on the three new hires. St. Louis, Boone, and Platte Counties will help in training our new employees. They will also assist in the updating and reinforcement of correct procedures for our current employees.

She said the position of lead clerk in the Independence office is vacant and they are trying to fill this position with someone who is experienced in documentation and in deeds. She also said that an ordinance is being introduced today which appropriates money to the Records Department. This money will be used to create the position of a second Assistant Director of Records. It will also be used for microfilming purposes and to hire temporary auditors.

The Records Department is behind on reconciling the financial aspects of the department and they want to hire temporary auditors to do the auditing so they can submit financial reports to the Finance Department. She said that progress is being made in the Records Department and the computer system installation is nearly complete. All of the conversions have been made from the old system to the new system through December 31, 1997.

Katheryn Shields said that the county has been negotiating with Kaiser and Humana on health insurance. Kaiser is within the bid lid. Humana has no lid and they have asked for an 18% increase which would mean a \$700,000.00 increase to Jackson County. Because of this, the county will go out for bid for health insurance.

Victor E. Callahan, Chairman, asked that the Administration meet with the Risk Insurance Committee prior to sending out bids. Katheryn Shields asked John Patrick Burnett, Chairman of the Committee, to set up the meeting soon as bids are scheduled to go out on Friday, September 11, 1998.

Katheryn Shields said that there are two anniversary events happening in Jackson County Parks. We will be celebrating the 50th Anniversary of the reconstruction of Block House #1 at Fort Osage and Parks and Recreation is sponsoring its first Rendevous.
