

**FIRST ADDENDUM**  
**LEGAL SERVICES AGREEMENT**  
(Miller Matter)

THIS FIRST AGREEMENT, made and entered into this 11<sup>th</sup> day of February, 2020, by and between **JACKSON COUNTY, MISSOURI**, hereinafter call "the County" and **SEYFERTH, BLUMENTHAL & HARRIS**, 4801 Main Street Ste. 310, Kansas City, MO 64112 (hereinafter called "Special Counsel").

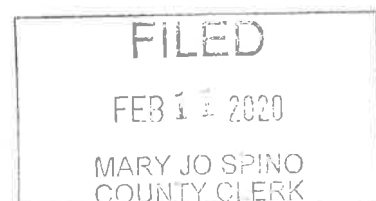
**WITNESSETH:**

WHEREAS, Legal Counsel has entered into a Legal Services Agreement dated April 26, 2019, whereunder Legal Counsel agreed to provide specialized legal advice, assistance, and representation to the County relating to an employment case styled *Teesha Miller v. Jackson County, Missouri* – Case No. 1816-CV28965, and;

WHEREAS, the parties now desire to increase the maximum sum available for services rendered under this Agreement.

NOW THEREFORE, in consideration of the foregoing and the terms and provisions herein contained, County and Legal Counsel respectively promise, covenant and agree with each other as follows:


1. Except as expressly provided herein, all provisions of the Legal Services Agreement dated April 26, 2019, between Legal Counsel and County shall remain in full force and effect.
2. The maximum sum to be paid by County to Legal Counsel shall be increased by the amount of \$56,600.00 for a new maximum total of \$120,100.00.



3. The First Addendum shall be effective as of December 1, 2019, and shall remain in effect, together with the Legal Services Agreement of April 26, 2019, until December 31, 2020.
4. This First Addendum to Agreement together with the Legal Services Agreement dated April 26, 2019, incorporates the entire understanding and agreement of the parties.
