WHEREAS, the Prosecuting Attorney has recommended a one-year extension of the grant period to allow for the continued distribution of grant funds to the City of Kansas City, MO, for the Neighborhood & Services, Graffiti Abatement, and Kansas City No Violence Alliance program areas; now therefore,

BE IT RESOLVED by the County Legislature of Jackson County, Missouri, that a oneyear extension to the JAG Grant be and is hereby is approved; and

BE IT FURTHER RESOLVED that all County officials be and are hereby authorized to execute any and all documents necessary to give effect to this extension.
