REQUEST SUMMARY	This ordinance appropriates \$26,898 in CARES Act funding to Environmental Health for replacement of pumps damaged by a large amount of materials flushed that are not soluble such as baby wipes and rags. Toilet paper shortages during the stay at home order caused individuals to use alternative items that should not be flushed. The plant is not designed to handle these items, and this caused clogs and severe damage to the pumps and grinders in the plant. During this time the increased flow at the plants also caused additional cost for chemicals and sludge pump outs.
