Dennis Waits, County Legislator, discussed opting out of the agreement with the Clty of Independence regarding the staffing of the animal shelter which is near completion. Jackson County agreed to fund the construction of the shelter and Independence agreed to staff the facility. However, the City of Independence is only offering to fund it at the same level as they have been in the past which is not sufficient because the new shelter is three times larger. The City of Independence is also proposing that a relinquishing fee be charged which has not been done in the past. Mr. Waits suggested contracting with non-profit organizations and allowing them to partner with municipalities in Jackson County for the staffing of the new animal shelter.
