## IN THE COUNTY LEGISLATURE OF JACKSON COUNTY, MISSOURI

**AN ORDINANCE** amending Load Limits Schedule B of Chapter 53 of the <u>Jackson County Code</u>, 1984.

**ORDINANCE NO. 4541**, July 1, 2013

INTRODUCED BY Bob Spence, County Legislator

WHEREAS, since the construction of Adams Dairy Parkway, Shrout Road south of Wyatt has seen an increase in truck traffic; and,

WHEREAS, due to the increase in truck traffic, and in response to requests for residents, the Acting Director of Public Works recommends that Shrout Road from Blue Springs city limits on the north to Lake Lotawana city limits on the south, be added to Schedule B, 12 Ton Load Limit, Designated Roadways; now therefore,

BE IT ORDAINED by the County Legislature of Jackson County, Missouri, as follows:

Section A. Enacting Clause. Schedule B of Chapter 53 of the <u>Jackson County Code</u>, 1984, is hereby amended by adding the following language:

Shrout Road - Blue Springs city limits to Lake Lotawana city limits



REQUEST SUMMARY	Chapter 53 of the County Code addresses load limits on County Roads. Since Adams Dairy Road has been built, Shrout road south of Wyatt, has seen an increase in truck traffic. In response to requests from residents on the road and in view of the new construction to the north, the public works department recommends that Shrout Road, from Blue Springs city limits on the north, to Lake Lotawana City limits on the south, be added to the "B" list in the code. Upon approval a load limit sign would be installed, limiting, truck traffic that is just driving through, to 12 tons, all other trucks with business on the road are limited to the State load limit.

## **OPERATION OF MOTOR VEHICLES**

5320. Motor Vehicles Subject to Weight Limits.

Motor vehicles which are operated on roadways are subject to the weight limitations imposed by this or other applicable ordinance for the roadway specified. (Ord. 692, Sec. 2, Eff. 4-21-79)

C/R: 5330.00 - 5332.00, Weight limitations.

5321. <u>Vehicle Operation in Excess of Weight Limits Prohibited.</u>

No motor vehicle shall be operated on any roadway which is subject to weight limitations whose gross weight exceeds the weight for which the vehicle has been licensed by the state. (Ord. 692, Sec. 4, Eff. 4-21-79)

C/R: 5330.00 - 5332.00, weight limitations and gross weight, defined.

5322. Load Limit Exceptions.

The load limitation imposed by this chapter do not prohibit the following. (O(rd. 692, Sec. 3, Eff. 4-21-79)

5322.1 Necessary to Conduct Business.

The load limitations imposed by this chapter do not prohibit the operation of motor vehicles, otherwise in violation of applicable load limits set by ordinance but not in excess of state load limits, to a destination located on a roadway which is necessary to the conduct of the business of the operator, provided that the roadway in question is used from the intersection nearest the destination point. (Ord. 692, Sec. 3.1, Eff. 4-21-79)

5322.2 Emergency Vehicles.

The load limitations imposed by this chapter do not prohibit the operation of law enforcement of fire fighting equipment or ambulances. (Ord. 692, Sec. 3.2, Eff. 4-21-79)

5322.3 School Bus.

The load limitations imposed by this chapter do not prohibit the operation of school buses. (Ord. 692, Sec. 3.3, Eff. 4-21-79)

C/R: 5316.00, school bus defined.

5322.4 Farm Equipment.

The load limitations imposed by this chapter do not prohibit the operation of farm equipment. (Ord. 692, Sec. 3.3, Eff. 4-21-79)

5322.5 County or Public Utility Vehicles.

The load limitations imposed by this chapter do not prohibit the operation of motor vehicles owned or operated by the county or public utilities or their contractors or material suppliers while engaged in the repair, maintenance or construction of roadways, bridges, right-of-way improvement or utility installations, equipment or fixtures. (Ord. 692, Sec. 3.4, Eff. 4-21-79)

5322.6 Special Permit, Vehicle Load Limitations.

The load limitations imposed by this chapter do not prohibit the operation of motor vehicles, otherwise in violation of applicable load limits, where the operator or owner of the vehicle first secures a permit for that operation from the Department of Public Works. (Ord. 692, Sec. 3.5, Eff. 4-21-79)

C/R: 5350.00 through 5324.00, relating to special permits.

5323. <u>Penalty, Violation of Vehicle Load Limit Code.</u>

The operation of motor vehicles in violation of the applicable load limits imposed by this chapter is a county ordinance violation which shall, on conviction, be punished by a fine calculated at one dollar (\$1) for each pound that the gross weight of the vehicle exceeds the applicable load limit. The fine shall not be less than one hundred (\$100) nor more than one thousand dollars (\$1,000). Ord. 692, Sec. 2, Eff. 4-21-79)

## WEIGHT LIMITS

5330. <u>Load Limits of Roadways</u>.

All roadways shall carry state load limits if not posted otherwise. (Ord. 692, Sec. 8, Eff. 4-21-79)

5331. <u>16,000 Pound Limit Roadways</u>.

No motor vehicle or combination of vehicles exceeding a gross weight of 16,000 pounds shall be moved or operated on the roadways listed in Schedule A of this chapter. (Ord. 692, Sec. 8, Eff. 4-21-79)

5332. Load Limits on Bridges.

The load limits imposed by this or any other ordinance for roadways do not apply to or affect the posted load limits established by the Department of Public Works for county bridges. (Ord. 692, Sec. 7.B, Eff. 4-21-79)

5333. <u>Twenty-four Thousand (24,000) Pound Limit Roadways</u>. No motor vehicle or combination of vehicles exceeding a gross weight of 24,000 pounds shall be moved or operated on the roadways listed in Schedule B of this chapter. (Ord. 1242, Eff. 9-26-84)
