AN ORDINANCE appropriating \$35,084.00 from the undesignated fund balance of the 2012 Collector's Maintenance Fund and awarding a contract for the furnishing of upgraded Electronic Payment Service Software for use by the Collection and Information Technology Departments to Sonant Corporation of San Diego, CA, at a cost to the County not to exceed \$28,290.00, as a sole source purchase.

ORDINANCE #4436, August 6, 2012

INTRODUCED BY Scott Burnett, County Legislator

WHEREAS, the County's current Electronic Payment Software (EPS) 4, which is used to process tax payer on-line credit card and e-check payments, is out-of-date and no longer in compliance with Payment Card Industry security standards; and,

WHEREAS, the Director of the Information Technology Department recommends the award of a contract for the purchase of the upgraded EPS 5 software from Sonant Corporation of San Diego, CA, as it is the current provider of the EPS 4 software and it is configured to work with the County's Ascend software; and

WHEREAS, section 1030.1, <u>Jackson County Code</u>, 1984, eliminates the requirement for competitive bidding when items to be purchased can be obtained from only one source and requires notification of and approval by the Legislature on such sole source purchases exceeding \$25,000.00; and,

WHEREAS, the Director of Finance and Purchasing recommends that he not take competitive bids with regard to said contract for the reason that Sonant Corporation is

the only company that provides the proprietary EPS software and is therefore a sole source; and,

WHEREAS, the additional hardware and software necessary for this upgrade will be provided by existing Term and Supply contracts, at an additional cost not to exceed \$6,794.00; and,

WHEREAS, an appropriation is necessary to place the funds in the appropriate spending accounts; and,

BE IT ORDAINED by the County Legislature of Jackson County, Missouri, that the following appropriation from the undesignated fund balance of 2012 Collector's Maintenance Fund be and hereby is made:

Memorandum: Upgrade of EPS Software to Become PCI Compliant.

The County's current version of Electronic Payment Service (EPS version 4) is no longer supported by Sonant. They will help us troubleshoot problems; however, they will not provide enhancements and would be unlikely to provide bug fixes. EPS 5, the current version, is fully supported and actively enhanced by Sonant.

EPS 5 is certified as a PCI (Payment Card Industry) compliant Payment Application. PCI compliance is the industry standard for ensuring the security and protection of consumer payment information. By being PCI compliant, the county will be better protected from liability related to any chance exposure of consumer payment or personally identifiable information. It is an IT initiative to become as fully PCI compliant as possible in the coming months. While there is other work to be done, acquiring EPS 5 is a major step in the right direction and is the most crucial piece of the puzzle. It protects us where we are currently most vulnerable.

The County's installation of AscendWeb is configured to work only with EPS. AscendWeb does support other payment processors; however, it would require a significant amount of time, money and testing and to reconfigure AscendWeb to work with a different payment processor.

We also have two custom components. The first custom component is for interfacing between EPS and the Ascend database. Thomson-Reuters would have to create a new custom component, for which we would be charged if we were to choose another payment processor. In addition to any charge, there are also time considerations for the development of this interface.

The second custom component is for interfacing between EPS and UMB. UMB developed and originally absorbed the cost of this component (per their bid/contract). A new component and/or interface would need to be developed if we were to choose another payment processor. Since this would be a change outside of their original bid, UMB would likely charge us for this development.

This updated proposal (P120723-01) reflects the change for not updating the total cost with the amount of the task to migrate EPS 4 transaction data to EPS 5 (line 3) from the previous proposal. An adjustment was made to the credit for the EPS 4 license in order to honor the total quoted in the previous proposal.

Per conference call discussion with you on 6/5/2012, this updated proposal (P120607-02) has added the quote for licensing a test copy of EPS 5 for D&T and migrating EPS 4 transactions to EPS 5 from 1/1/2006 to current.

Sonant is pleased to submit this attached proposal (P120510-01) to upgrade Sonant's Electronic Payment Server that Supports Manatron's Tax web application from EPS 4 to the PA-DSS compliant EPS 5 per the request during our telecon last fall.

Overview

The PCI Council controls the requirements for data security associated with credit card electronic payment processing. To meet these requirements, Sonant has developed a new payment processing engine called EPS 5 that is PA-DSS compliant. A new server is required to host the EPS 5 product and its associated instance of the SQL Server that will contain the transaction data, encryption keys, EPS 5 configuration settings, etc. Because this server can be a standard Windows unit it is assumed that the County will choose to provide and support it. As an option, Sonant can provide and support the server. The server should be located on the County's protected vlan subnet.

Functionality added to EPS 4

EPS 5 was developed in accordance with strict PA-DSS procedural requirements and is listed by the PCI Council as an approved PA-DSS application. It adds the following functionality to EPS 4:

- Automatic reversal of transactions, if supported by the selected credit card processor, to release the
 cardholder's earmarked funds when risk management rules are not met. This reversal occurs before
 Settlement. If the reversal transaction fails to process properly the transaction will be voided.
- EPS Service runs under a dedicated service account.
- Mandatory masking of sensitive transaction data.
- Password rules have been enhanced to meet PA-DSS requirements.

- Key Management is now performed using EPS Manager. This feature requires dual Key Custodians and two-factor Authentication.
 - o Two-factor authentication is not needed if logging in from within the CDE.
- Data Management support for truncating of PAN data and purging of transaction data in the EPS database. The rules relating to the above are configurable in EPS Manager.
- A new module, the EPS Financial Manager, is a browser-based administrative tool used by an
 organization's finance staff for accessing daily reports and transactional data for research and
 reconciliations and to do refunds, if supported by the card processor.
 - Two-factor authentication is not required for EPS 5 Financial Manager logging in from within the CDE.
- EPS client support for shopping cart items to be spread across multiple transactions. E.g., a separate transaction for the items associated with each merchant account.
- The existing user audit trail has been enhanced to meet PA-DSS requirements.

County Payment System EPS 5 Upgrade

Tasks to be accomplished

- The County will provide a new server to host the new EPS 5 software and its associated instance of the SQL Server database. The server will meet or exceed the requirements specified below in "Minimum Requirements for a customer-provided Production EPS 5 server". Sonant can provide the server as an optional, extra cost item.
- The County will provide the license and media for a copy of MS SQL Server 2008 R2 Standard Edition database for the Production server database software that will be installed on the production server that will host the EPS 5 software.
- Sonant will remotely install and configure (per PA-DSS requirements) the SQL Server database on the new EPS 5 server.
- Sonant will remotely install and configure (per PA-DSS requirements) the EPS 5 software on the server.
- Sonant will provide a new EPS 5 SDK to Manatron
- Manatron will modify the web applications interface to EPS to use the EPS 5 SDK.
- Manatron will install the modified web application on the County's test web server.
- Sonant will migrate a sample of EPS 4 test transactions, not production transactions, to the server.
 [Note: If production transactions that contain the actual PAN data are used the server has to be subject to full PCI-DSS as of the time the transactions are migrated.]
- Sonant and the County will confirm that the migrated transactions match the original EPS 4 test transactions.
- The County, with Sonant's support, will perform acceptance testing of EPS 5 using the new server and the modified web application.
- After completion of the testing, Sonant will migrate the production EPS 4 transactions, beginning with 1/01/2006, to the new production EPS 5 server.
- The County will perform limited verification of the migrated transactions.
- Upon completion of verification:
 - The County will accept the EPS 5 software.
 - Sonant and the County will review the cutover steps, password rules and fallback plan.

- Public access to the production web server will be disabled.
- If there are any new EPS 4 transactions since the migration an EPS 4 Settlement will be performed and the new transactions will be migrated to the new production EPS 5 server.
- Public access to the production web will be enabled.
- Sonant will conduct a remote training course of up to 2 hours for up to 4 County staff members in the use of the browser-based EPS 5 Financial Manager program.
- Sonant will conduct an EPS 5 software administration training course of up to 2 hours for up to 3 County staff members. (Both classes will be conducted remotely on the same day).
- ❖ After several days of successful use of EPS 5 by the County's financial staff, Sonant will re-key the migrated and new transactions in the EPS 5 SQL Production database, using the PA-DSS approved encryption.
- The County will create the virtual server that will host the D&T applications, services, and database.
 - As a virtual server it requires 4 GB RAM, 2 CPUs, and 100GB disk, as a minimum.
- Sonant will install and configure the instance of SQL Express database for EPS 5 on the D&T.
- Sonant will install and configure the test copy of EPS 5 on the D&T.
- Sonant will migrate a set of EPS 4 test transactions to the EPS 5 format on the D&T.
- Court will install the modified web application on the D&T
- The Court, with Sonant's support, will perform limited verification testing of the test web payment pages, the test copy of EPS 5 and its database.

Assumptions

- Handling and storage of EPS 5 crypto keys will be subject to strict PA-DSS requirements. Sonant will
 provide the key custodian services to the County at no additional cost providing the County is covered
 by an active Sonant Maintenance contract.
- County will provide MS SQL Server 2008 R2 Standard Edition license for the new EPS 5 Production server.
- The new EPS 5 server will not host any other software that is accessed from outside the CDE.
- The County is responsible for application of patches to the operating system and for implementing and managing the virus protection on the new server.
- Backup of EPS production data should be done within the CDE.
- The County will provide a copy of the Manatron Ascend DLL for new D&T system.
- Testing will be done using the new EPS 5 production server before it is put into public use.
- County will provide new virtual server to host the D&T copy of EPS and its SQL express database.
- During installation, configuration and testing, the County will provide Sonant with VPN access to the new EPS 5 server and the D&T server.
- Sonant will have administrative rights to the EPS 5 Production server and the D&T server.
- No changes are being made to the accepted card types; only Visa and MasterCard will be accepted.
- Once in production, the County will provide Sonant with VPN access to the EPS Production server and the D&T server for maintenance and problem resolution.
- Support of EPS 5 for both Production and D&T will be covered as part of this year's maintenance contract with Sonant. At renewal, 1/1/2013, support for these licenses will be added to the maintenance contract.

• County is responsible for getting the Test credit card and echeck, and arranging for Test environment with UMB.
