BHCC conducted a survey with screening participants which included questions on various health topics. Screening participants were residents of the Greater Kansas City, Missouri area and Kansas City, Kansas. Here is a summary of our findings:

PRIMARY CARE PROVIDER



26% reported no primary care provider or medical home

HEALTH INSURANCE

30% were uninsured;
49% had Medicaid or Medicare or both;
21% had private health insurance



CARDIOVASCULAR DISEASE



64% had three or more risk factors for cardiovascular disease

HYPERTENSION & DIABETES

54% were diagnosed with Hypertension;
21% were diagnosed with Diabetes; **17%** were diagnosed with both Hypertension and Diabetes



BLOOD PRESSURE



63% exhibited abnormally high blood pressure;
15% were referred to seek immediate medical attention; **7%** were referred to seek emergent care
