The City of Kansas City has been awarded JAG funds by the Department of Justice for local law enforcement purposes in the amount of \$608,615 of which \$264,216 has been allocated to the Jackson County Prosecutor's Office to fund two assistant prosecutors, one data and information analyst and one assistant prosecutor/diversion manager. To complete the project, the Prosecutor's Office will provide an additional \$74,231 to pay for the unfunded portions of the encumbants. The City of Kansas City is the designated fiscal agent.
