Fred Siems, Chief Administrative Officer, said Mike Sanders, County Executive, was unable to attend the legislative meeting but asked him to report that Lake Fest had the largest attendance last Saturday, June 21, 2008.

Bob Spence, County Legislator, asked if the Administration was considering a 4 day work week for County employees.

Fred Siems said the Administration is currently conducting a study and explained that it is not considering eliminating days that County offices are open.

Henry C. Rizzo, County Legislator, said he is happy Jackson County is trying to get property appraisals correct.

Fred Siems explained that Senate Bill 711 applies to first class charter counties as well as the City of St. Louis.

Jim Nunnelly, Acting Director of COMBAT, asked for recommendations from the County Legislature for people to serve on the COMBAT Commission as the deadline is July 10, 2008.

James D. Tindall, County Legislator, said applicants must have knowledge of crime/drug prevention and the criminal justice system.

Dan Tarwater, County Legislator, said there is an application to be completed by applicants.
