

IN THE COUNTY LEGISLATURE OF JACKSON COUNTY, MISSOURI

AN ORDINANCE submitting to the qualified voters of Jackson County, Missouri, at the primary election to be held on August 2, 1994, a question authorizing Jackson County to renew, levy, and collect a fee of \$3.00 on each instrument recorded by the Department of Records through August 28, 2000, for the purpose of providing funds for assistance to homeless families.

ORDINANCE 2298, May 31, 1994

INTRODUCED BY James D. Tindall, County Legislator

WHEREAS, the County Legislature of Jackson County, Missouri, finds and concludes that it is necessary for the health, safety, and welfare of the citizens of Jackson County to seek the approval of the voters of Jackson to renew the \$3.00 fee on each instrument recorded by the Department of Records through August 28, 2000, to provide funds for assistance to homeless families; therefore,

BE IT ORDAINED by the County Legislature of Jackson County, Missouri, as follows:

Section 1. Pursuant to the provisions of § 67.1063, RSMo Supp. 1993, there is hereby submitted to the qualified voters of Jackson County, Missouri, at the primary election to be held on August 2, 1994, a question to approve the renewal, levy, and collection of fees as more particularly set forth and described in Section 2 of this ordinance.

Section 2. The qualified voters at said election shall vote by ballot and the ballots to be used at said election shall contain the following language:

JACKSON COUNTY, MISSOURI
QUESTION # 2
PRIMARY ELECTION
AUGUST 2, 1994
OFFICIAL BALLOT

Shall the County of Jackson be authorized to provide funding for assistance to homeless families, as set forth in sections 67.1062 - 67.1071 of the Revised Statutes of Missouri, by renewing the \$3.00 fee on the recording of each instrument by the Department of Records through August 28, 2000, in addition to any other fees required by law?

Section 3. The Clerk of the Legislature is hereby authorized and directed to notify the Kansas City and Jackson County Boards of Election Commissioners of the adoption of this Ordinance no later than 5:00 p.m. on June 7, 1994, and to include in said notification all of the terms and provisions required by § 115.125, RSMo 1986.

Effective Date: This Ordinance shall be effective immediately upon its passage by the County Executive.
