REQUEST SUMMARY	Santa Fe Rd bridge over the BNSF RR, located about ¼ miles south west of the Historic Fort Osage, is eligible for replacement in the Off System Bridge Program (BRO). This program provides for 80% funding on eligible costs for the project. The Local Entity is responsible for the 20% match. This project will be a joint effort with the town of Sibley and the Burlington Northern Santa Fe Rail Road. The current structure is an old thru truss steel railroad bridge that was moved to this site, erected and modified to handle vehicle traffic. This one lane bridge is the only access to the North part of the town and the Fort Osage Park. The Public Works Department has requested funding and received approval from Missouri Highways and Transportation department for this project.  We request that an ordinance be prepared authorizing the County Executive to enter into an agreement with Missouri Department of Transportation for the design and construction of this project in the town of Sibley.
