

Proposed Program

Parade Route:

The parade route starts at Main & Pershing in downtown Kansas City at 10 am, Labor Day, September 2nd, 2013. At the start turn East on Pershing to Grand, turn North on Grand to 20th Street, turn West on 20th Street to Main, turn South on Main to Pershing, turn West on Pershing to Kessler, turn South on Kessler to Penn Valley Park Festival Special planning underway Labor Tribute: 911 Victims and all the Fallen!

- 1) All Nations Flag Company will loan and 8x12 flag for the tribute
- 2) Operating Engineers #101 will rig and hoist the flag, to be raised off the Jackson County Sheriffs Color Guard that will be in the intersection of Main & Pershing. So it will not touch the ground, just before 10am. Two tower cranes will be diagonal in the intersection.
- 3) Mayor James will lead the Pledge
- 4) "National Anthem, Sterling Brown singer and a MMF Sax accompanying."
- 5) Shrine Temple Pipers & Drums Unit will come forward and play "Amazing Grace and Another Tribute Song" for all first responders.
- 6) Sheriff's Dept. will perform a 21 Gun Salute for the Military
- 7) The Bugler, Dan Needham will be standing on the hill of the Liberty Memorial at our backs, the guns will then signal Taps to be played.
- 8) Welcome to Kansas City and Labor Unions acknowledgement by Mayor James.

All Nations Flag Company a labor day parade partner is selling the 4x6 American made Flags, to us for 10% discount off of .33 cents each. .

<u>Balloons</u>: Free Helium will be available on the picnic grounds for balloons for any organization that wants to fill their balloons for the children.

Entries:

The 911 Tribute will start promptly at 10am.

Start time for parade moving will most likely change depending on Grand Street opening after Irish Festival and the 911 Tribute.

A low rider car club, Saddle clubs, floats and several hobby clubs participate.

All organizations are encouraged to invite favorite office holders to participate within their floats. All entries are encouraged to transport riders, because of the sometimes extreme heat of the roadways and the movement goes a lot faster.

Shiners Temple is gathering their entire parade entertainment unit to participate this year the contact estimated their Parade entry of 100 display items. They have requested to go all together they will be in the middle of the parade and will require their own lane on staging.

Picnic

Invitations to Whitman's Air Force, Base council; 14 Mayors and Councils, Base command- General's office and all units with their families. KC Fire Dept and KC Police Dept. and families have been invited by special invitations. Shriner's clowns will be at the Picnic, we will make a \$500 donation to the Children's Hospital via the Ararat Shrine Temple.

The stage musical entertainment is provided by the Mutual Musicians Foundation and features several artist. It is a musical festival format that will rotate throughout the day

Our media partners 38Spot and 41 will have a booth with their large balloon and giveaways!

Local #101, is sponsoring the skid of ice in the freezer on site free to the organizations at the Festival, also the FREE 1,000 hotdog & brat, meals under the tent, the BBQ Cook-Off Judging will be there and any Military families. They are also marshaling the parade and provide the golf carts. Including 149 -30second ads on KSHB Channel 41 announcing the event.

BBQ Cook-off

Winner Trophies will go to the Union Hall or Organization that is being represented, ribbons/metals are being donated by Awards' and T's to each participant.

Three categories judged: Beef Brisket, Pork Ribs, Chicken Thighs; Teams standings are 1st, 2nd, 3rd in each category with no entry fee.

Judging is at 2:00pm at the tent public FOOD TENT there are two public food tents. Penn Valley Park is available to the BBQ teams from 8am Sunday, Sept. 1st all day Monday to 12am -Sept. 3rd.

Children's Area

Shriners clowns will entertain in the children's area. Several Professional Sports Team Mascots will be stopping by to entertain the kids.

We will have 3 to 4 Inflatables, free cotton candy and snow cones for everyone.

There will be the mobile arcade that is free play all day.

A Moto Cross Stunt Team provides exhibitions throughout the day.

Fund Separation

Event organizing is provided by the Greater KC Labor Day Association and its formational board is made up of the administration of Plumbers Local #8, the International Brotherhood of Electrical Workers Local #53 and Operating Engineers Local #101. The organizations created the GKC Labor Day Association to promote any activities to provide within the Jackson County a celebration of Labor all Labor on the day designated Labor Day. All Funds are designated to provide an entertaining and fun day for all people in the Jackson County area and beyond through a committee of all Labor Organizations residing within the Jackson County area including some statewide Labor Organizations not only in Missouri but also in Kansas. The 2013 event is the 7th time the labor community has come together to provide an area wide public celebration benefiting the residents in Jackson County. The event is structured around the benefits that labor organizations can provide as a public or open venue highlighting the hard work, dedication and sacrifice of all labor of people within Jackson County that benefits the area.

Approach & Method

- The grassroots approach is utilized through a planning committee made up of approximately 144
 representatives of the labor community from Unions and labor promotional organizations. The planning
 committee is encouraged to participate through open communications through their networks contacting
 their members and business partners in order to create a celebration for Labor Day that reflects many
 interests, hobbies and performance groups.
- 2. Consistent planning, direction and messaging is provided through one of the volunteers that is also one of the founders of the event. Vicki Tarpley, a professional marketing representative and Director, cross networks and promotes throughout the community to benefit the growth of the celebration.
 - This 2013 Parade event did access the First Responders and Military; In Service and Veterans
 including the VFW and Ararat Shrine Temple to promote the 911 Tribute to the Fallen.
 - This 2013 Festival event did access the 18th & Vine area with the Mutual Musicians Foundation stage presentations of Blues and Jazz. Cross promoting nationally the MMF documentary.

- This 2013 Festival event did access the people interested in BBQ Competition with a free Cook-Off.
- The 2014 Parade event will access public education at the High School level with a Marching Band Competition within the Parade for scholarship awards for High School Band Departments.
- The 2014 Festival event will access the general public with the addition and promotion of a longer event that will conclude with a Fireworks Display.
- The 2014 Festival event will access the general public with the addition of a radio partner to help promote a musical presentation of Classic Rock & Roll.
- 3. Crowdfunding by engaging through social media. Developing fundraising events, two events are being scheduled a "Trapshooting and BBQ" for November 2013 and a Golf Tournament, May 1st, "May Day Golf Tournament" for 2014.

Evaluation

The committee measures success through participation and attendance.

2011 the 6th event we had 100 entries that represented 200 entities with a crowd count of 10,000 with 9 organizations picnicking at the festival. The cost was \$12,000.

2013 the 7th event we will have approximately 150 entries that will triple in entities participating, with 15 organizations picnicking, already the forecast is on track to double from 2011

Notification

In 2013 event we will hang a banner on the stage at the Festival with all of the sponsors listed. Sponsors are also mentioned on www.facebook.com/KCLaborDay and logos will be added August 30th on the banner photo. The sponsor banner will also hang at the special fundraising events and will be mentioned in the Labor Beacon Newspaper and through press release of sponsors.
