**AN ORDINANCE** transferring \$26,288.00 within and appropriating \$66,288.00 from the undesignated fund balance of the 2012 Anti-Drug Sales Tax Fund, and authorizing the extension of the Project Safe Neighborhoods grant awarded by the Kansas City Metropolitan Crime Commission.

**ORDINANCE NO. 4480,** November 19, 2012

**INTRODUCED BY** James D. Tindall, County Legislator

WHEREAS, by Ordinance 4276, dated December 6, 2010, the Legislature did accept the Project Safe Neighborhoods grant awarded by the Kansas City Metropolitan Crime Commission in the amount of \$39,229.00 for use by the Prosecuting Attorney's Office; and,

WHEREAS, the purpose of this grant is to partially fund the salary of one attorney assigned to the U.S. Attorney's Office for the Western District of Missouri; and,

WHEREAS, the Kansas City Metropolitan Crime Commission has authorized an extension of the grant period to September 30, 2013, with additional grant funds in the amount of \$40,000.00; and,

WHEREAS, in order to complete the project, the Prosecuting Attorney's Office requires an additional \$26,288.11, to be sourced from its budget; and,

WHEREAS, a transfer and appropriation are necessary to place the matching and grant

funds in the proper spending accounts; and,

WHEREAS, the County Executive recommends said transfer and appropriation; now therefore,

# PROJECT SAFE NEIGHBORHOOD MEMORANDUM OF AGREEMENT

## **AMENDMENT**

This amendment to the original Memorandum of Agreement (MOA) dated on or about December 17, 2010 is entered into by and between the Kansas City Metropolitan Crime Commission (KCMCC) and the Jackson County Prosecutor (hereinafter referred to as JCP).

#### PURPOSE:

The KCMCC and the JCP agree to amend the original MOA for the purpose of extending grant period previously stated in the original as concluding in December, 2012. The original MOU states that "Parties to the Agreement both agree that continuation of the agreement past the initial 24 month period will be contingent on the continued grant funding for PSN." \$40,000 in PSN funds will be available to extend this agreement to September 30, 2013.

#### AGREEMENT:

- 1. Term: The term of this Amendment to the original MOA shall be for an approximate 9 month period commencing on or about when the previous grant funding is expended in December 2012, or as soon thereafter as possible and ending on or about September 30, 2013. Parties to this amendment both agree that continuation beyond the period shall be contingent on continued funding for PSN.
- 2. Authority: This MOA is established pursuant to the following provision(s).

Grant Number BJA FY 2011 PSN - Grant Award Number 2011-GP-BX-0080

- 3. Services: JCP, through the United States Attorney for the Western District of Missouri, agrees to provide the professional services of one prosecutor attorney as set forth in the original contract:
  - a. One prosecutor assigned to the U.S. Attorney's Office for the Western District of Missouri.

All other provisions of this Amendment, Services section shall remain the same as those established in the original MOA and/or its amendments.

4. **Relationship:** Remains as established in the original MOA and/or its amendments.

- Payment: Process remains as established in the original MOA and/or its amendments. \$40,000 is available to expend during the approximate 9 month period and invoicing may occur on a monthly or quarterly basis.
