
WHEREAS, the Fort Osage School District shall reimburse the County for the services rendered by the School Resource Officer in the yearly amount of \$79,653.91 for the period of July 1, 2013, through June 30, 2014; now therefore,

**BE IT RESOLVED** by the County Legislature of Jackson County, Missouri, that the County Executive be, and hereby is, authorized to execute the attached cooperative agreement with the Fort Osage School District.


