They also passed a 1/2 cent sales tax and he would like to get more information on what Green Bay did for the renovation of Lambeau Field. The County passed the tax and they hold aside 4,000 seats just for people within the County. They have other ideas of things they do just for the residents of Brown County.

Fred Arbanas said he believes the stadium is owned by stockholders who live in Wisconsin.

Dennis Waits, County Legislator, handed Mr. Tarwater information on the stadium.

Dennis Waits said the information is interesting but he received it from Bob Spence.

Bob Spence, County Legislator, said he received the information from one of his constituents.
