A RESOLUTION transferring \$29,700.00 within the 2018 Park Fund and authorizing the purchase of a Jacobsen Truckster HD and core harvester for use by the Parks + Rec Department to Kansas Golf and Turf of Lenexa, KS, under the terms and conditions of NJPA Contract No. 062117-JCS, an existing competitively bid contract, declaring certain existing equipment surplus personal property, and authorizing its disposal by way of trade-in.

RESOLUTION NO.19947, August 6, 2018

INTRODUCED BY Tony Miller, County Legislators

WHEREAS, the Parks + Rec Department requires a new Jacobsen Truckster HD and core harvester for use at the Fred Arbanas Golf Course and requests the surplus and trade-in of an existing item of equipment that has exceeded its expected lifespan; and,

WHEREAS, pursuant to section 103.4 of the Jackson County Code, the Director of Finance and Purchasing recommends the purchase of a Jacobsen Truckster HD and Jacobsen core harvester, from Kansas Golf and Turf of Lenexa, KS, under the terms and conditions of NJPA Contract 062117-JCS, an existing competitively bid contract; and,

WHEREAS, pursuant to section 1142 of the Jackson County Code, the Director of Finance and Purchasing recommends that a 2000 Cushman Truckster be declared surplus and used as a trade-in for the purchase of the new equipment; now therefore,

BE IT RESOLVED by the County Legislature of Jackson County, Missouri, that the following transfer within the 2018 Park Fund be and hereby is made:

BE IT FURTHER RESOLVED that the existing 2000 Cushman Truckster, described on the attached documentation, be and hereby is declared surplus personal property and that the Director of Finance and Purchasing be and hereby is authorized to dispose of said personal property by way of trade-in, as recommended; and,

BE IT FURTHER RESOLVED that the Director of Finance and Purchasing be and hereby is authorized to make all payments, including final payment on the contract thereby made.

Effective Date: This Resolution shall be effective immediately upon its passage by a majority of the Legislature.



Re: Cushman Truckster & Core Harvester

Our core harvester is a 1996 and was designed to mount on a 1996 Cushman truckster. This unit setup picks up the aeration plugs during our Spring and Fall aeration. The Cushman and John Deere Gators are used daily as a golf course work horse with our staff. We are constantly making repairs to the harvester and managed to "marry" it to a 2000 Cushman Truckster. This has not been an ideal match, but with some customization, we have made do. The 2000 Cushman is used for fertilizer applications, pulling top dresser, etc.. Fertilizer has salt properties and has caused a great deal of rust on our Cushman. We have also had to make several hydraulic repairs to all 3 units, as well as numerous welds.

The Cushman and core harvester are the top two things on the 2018 Capital list for the golf course to replace. The quotes are \$22,400 with a \$500 trade-in on the Jacobsen Truckster XD and \$6,000 for a Core Harvester. The quotes and surplus forms are attached along with a picture of both pieces. We will separate the pieces before they are removed from our property. Kansas G&T will be taking the old truckster & Purple Wave will auction the core harvester.

The funds for the purchase of the core harvester and truckster will need to be transferred from 003-1602-55010 Park Fund – Maintenance & Operations – Regular Salaries to 003-1602-58170 Park Fund – Maintenance & Operations – Other Equipment.

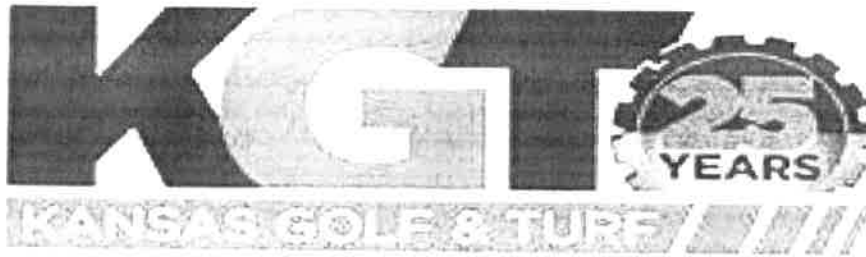



