WHEREAS, Mr. Mansur was a Board member and President at the Society for Environmental Journalists for 18 years; and,

WHEREAS, Mr. Mansur in June 2011, became the Director of Communications for the Jackson County Prosecutor where in addition to media relations, he helped the office oversee a variety of community and violence reduction programs, including the KC NoVA project aimed at reducing violent crime in Kansas City; and,

WHEREAS, Mr. Mansur is known as a dedicated and passionate public servant:

- Who has been on-call 24/7 literally to manage media relations for over 13 years;
- Who has served as the voice of the Prosecutor's Office;

- Who has received complaints, criticism, some threats, and on rare occasion, praise for the office;
- Who has been described as the Granddad of Crime Fighting;
- Who has been described as a Pessimist, but who is an Optimist about reducing crime;
- Who is described as an Advocate for data transparency and one who is informed by credible Data for decision-making;
- Who never misses a deadline, but comes awfully close;
- Whose North Star has been to improve community trust in the system and for the system to be worthy of their trust; and,

WHEREAS, Mr. Mansur is a loyal husband, father and friend, an avid reader, soccer player, and coach who has had the privilege to be married to Pattie for almost 42 years and who is enthusiastic about learning new things; now therefore,
